PLACEMAT ASSEMBLY

- **1.** Sew (1) **A** 2" \times 9-1/2" rectangle to the opposite short sides of (1) **I** 9 -1/2" \times 14-1/2" panel rectangle, followed by (1) **A** 2" \times 17-1/2" rectangle to top and bottom of **IA** unit.
- 2. Repeat step 1 for remaining placemats using **B**, **C** and **H** rectangle border strips.





Make (1) of each.





FINISHING: Layer placemat tops, batting and backing together to form sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **F** 2-1/4" strips.



STAR BLOCK ASSEMBLY

- **3. FLYING GEESE UNITS:** Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (2) **A** 2" squares. Place (1) square, right side together (RST), at a corner of (1) **J** 2" x 3-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal (1) **A** corner triangle. Repeat with another **A** 2" square at the opposite corner of the same **J** rectangle. Make (12) **AJ Flying Geese Units**.
- **4.** Add (1) **J** 2" square to each side of (1) **AJ** Flying Geese Unit. Make 2, set aside.
- **5.** Sew (1) **AJ** Flying Geese Unit to the opposite sides of (1) **A** 3-1/2" square to make center row. Note proper rotation of Flying Geese Units. Add **AJ/J** unit to top and bottom of center row. Trim block to 6-1/2" square.







6. Repeat steps 3-5 to make (3) of each Star Block below, using C-F 2" and 3-1/2" squares:

4. AJ/J UNIT











7. STRIP BORDER: Sew together via long edge (1) **J** 3-1/2" x 18-1/2", (1) **G** 2-1/2" x 18-1/2" rectangle (1) **C** 2-1/2" x 18-1/2" rectangle and (1) **B** 2-1/2" x 18-1/2" rectangle. Make 2 Units.





RUNNER ASSEMBLY

8. Arrange and sew together (5) Star Blocks into three rows as shown. Note proper placement of blocks.



9. Add Strip Border Units to short opposite sides of Runner Center. Note proper placement of units.



FINISHING: Layer runner, batting and backing together to form sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **G** 2-1/4" strips.
