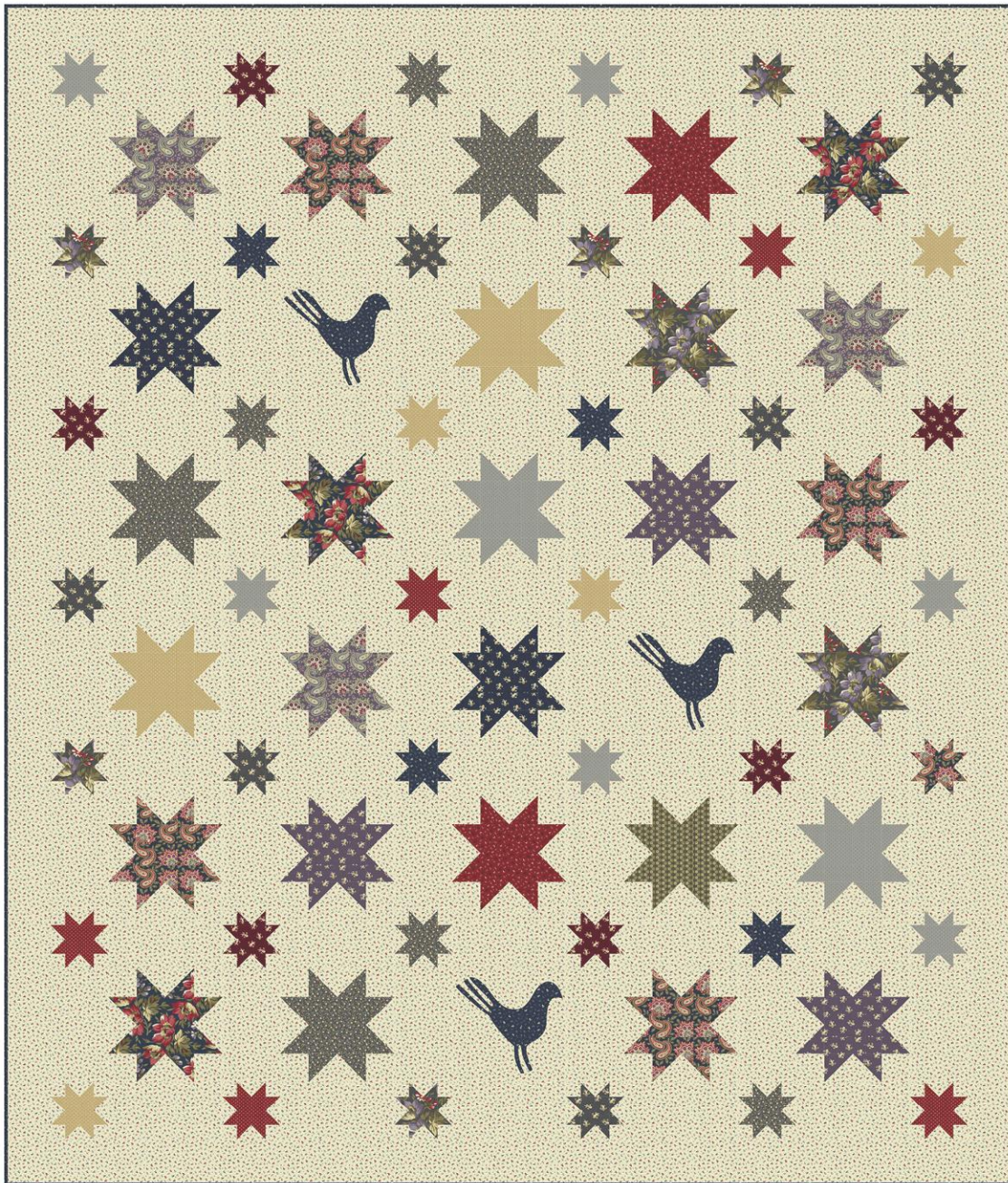

Constructing Star Blocks

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2 1/2" A square. Place marked square, right sides together, on (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" J rectangle. Sew on drawn line, trim 1/4" away from sewn line, and press open. Repeat on the opposite end to complete (1) flying geese unit. Repeat to make (4) A/J flying geese units.



2. Sew (2) flying geese units to the opposite sides of (1) 4 1/2" A square to make a row.





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3. Sew (2) 2 1/2" J squares to the opposite short sides of (1) flying geese unit to make a row. Repeat to make (2) rows.



4. Sew rows together to complete (1) 8 1/2" square star block.



5. Make the total number of blocks indicated using the following fabrics:

4 blocks: C

3 blocks: A, D, G, L

2 blocks: B, E, K, M, O

1 block: P

Constructing Star Cornerstones

6. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 1 1/2" B square. Place marked square, right sides together, on (1) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" J rectangle. Sew on drawn line, trim 1/4" away from sewn line, and press open. Repeat on the opposite end to complete (1) flying geese unit. Repeat to make (4) B/J flying geese units.



7. Sew (2) flying geese units to the opposite sides of (1) 2 1/2" B square to make a row.



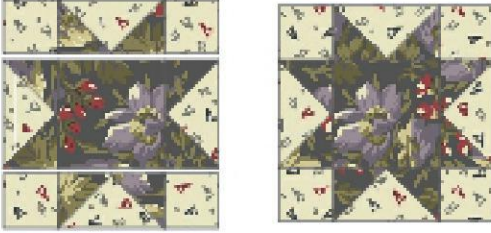


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8. Sew (2) 1 1/2" J squares to the opposite short sides of (1) flying geese unit to make a row. Repeat to make (2) rows.



9. Sew rows together to complete (1) 4 1/2" square star cornerstone.



10. Make the total number of blocks indicated using the following fabrics:

6 blocks: F, H, M

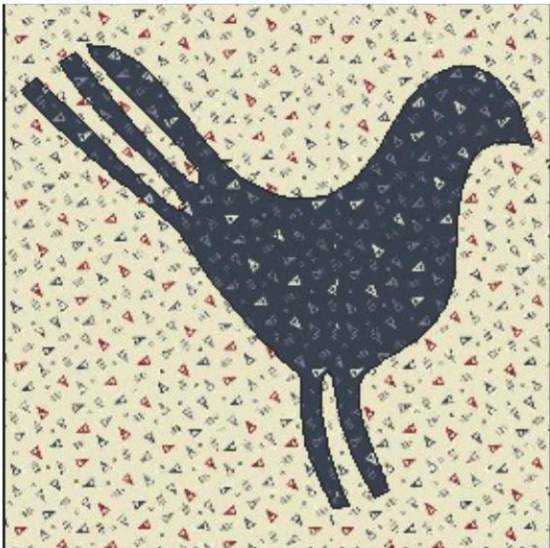
5 blocks: B, L, N

4 blocks: I, O

1 block: C

Constructing applique blocks

11. Using applique method of choice, sew (1) I bird applique piece on (1) 8 1/2" J square. Repeat to make a total of 3 blocks.

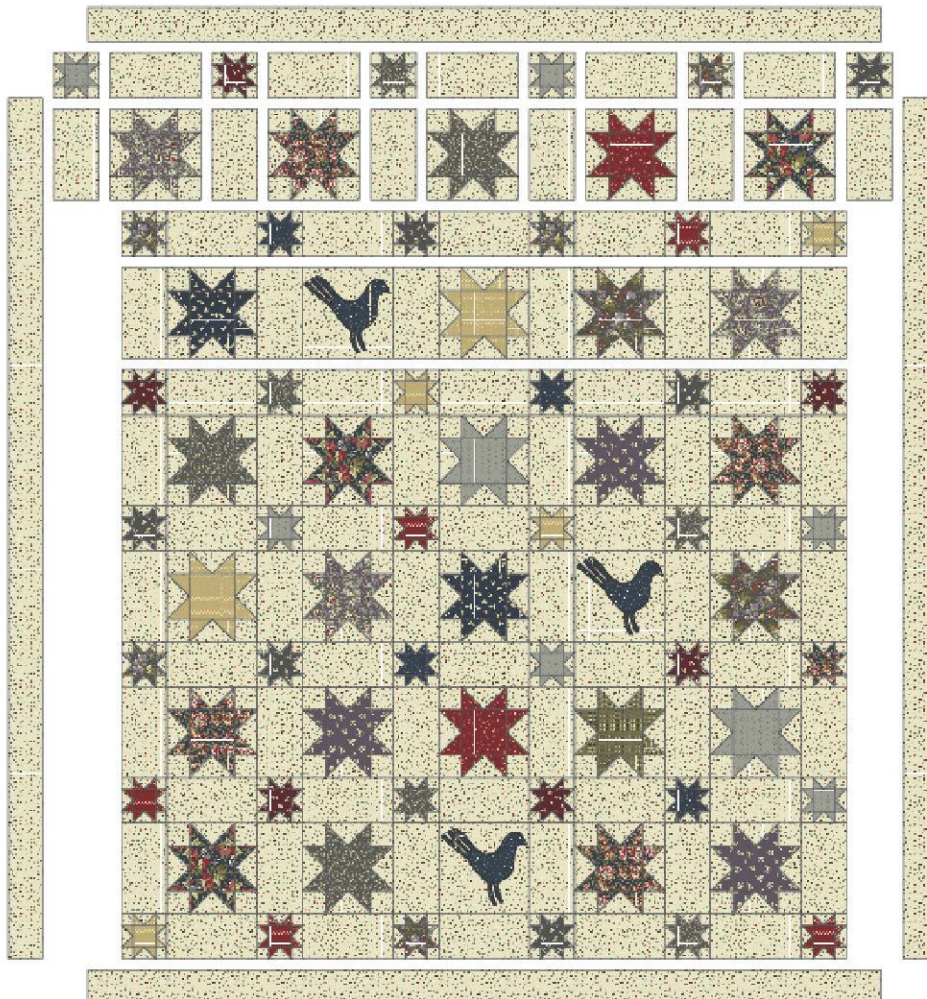




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Quilt Assembly

12. Sew together (5) blocks (star or bird applique) alternating with (6) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" J sashing rectangles to make a row. Make (6) block rows.
13. Sew together (6) star cornerstones alternating with (5) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" J sashing rectangles to make a sashing row. Make (7) block rows.
14. Sew together the sashing rows alternating with block rows to complete the quilt center.
15. Outer border. Sew (2) 3 1/2" x 76 1/2" J strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 3 1/2" x 70 1/2" J strips to the remaining opposite short sides to complete quilt top.



Finishing

1. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich and quilt as desired.
2. Bind the quilt using the (8) 2 1/4" x WOF I strips.

Template shown in reverse at 100%.
Applique template is provided without seam allowance. If needleturn applique method is used, add seam allowance when cutting bird applique pieces.
