Backing - 3-1/4 yards Batting - 58" x 66" piece

General Instructions:

- A. All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- B. Read through all instructions before beginning your project.

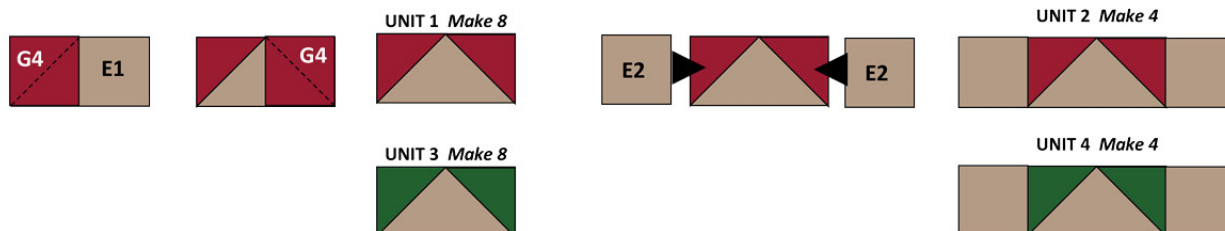
Piecing Instructions: (Refer to block diagrams below for proper fabric placement)

1. Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of (1) **G4** square. Place G square in one corner of (1) **E1** rectangle and sew on diagonal line. Press G open towards E corner. Trim excess fabric on reverse side to 1/4". Repeat on other side to create **UNIT 1**. Square to 3" X 5-1/2", make (8).



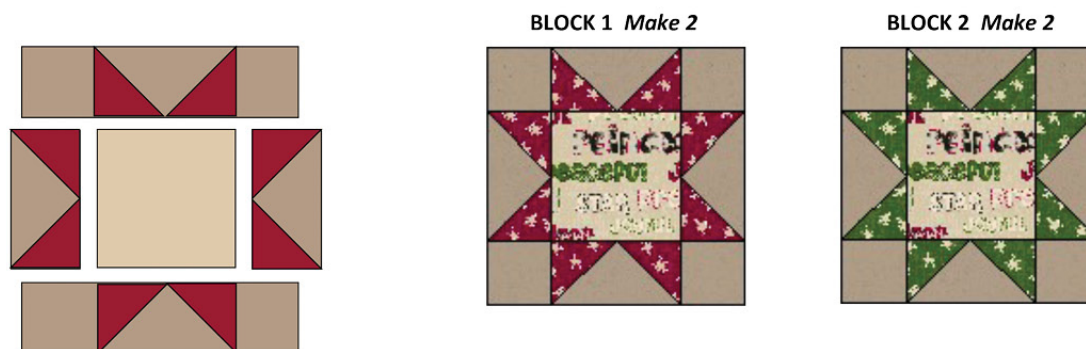
Strips

2. Sew (1) E2 square to each side of (1) UNIT 1 to create UNIT 2. Square to 3" X 10-1/2", make (4).
3. Repeat step 1 using F4 squares and E1 rectangles to create UNIT 3s, make (8).
4. Repeat step 2 using E2 squares and UNIT 3s to create UNIT 4s, make (4).



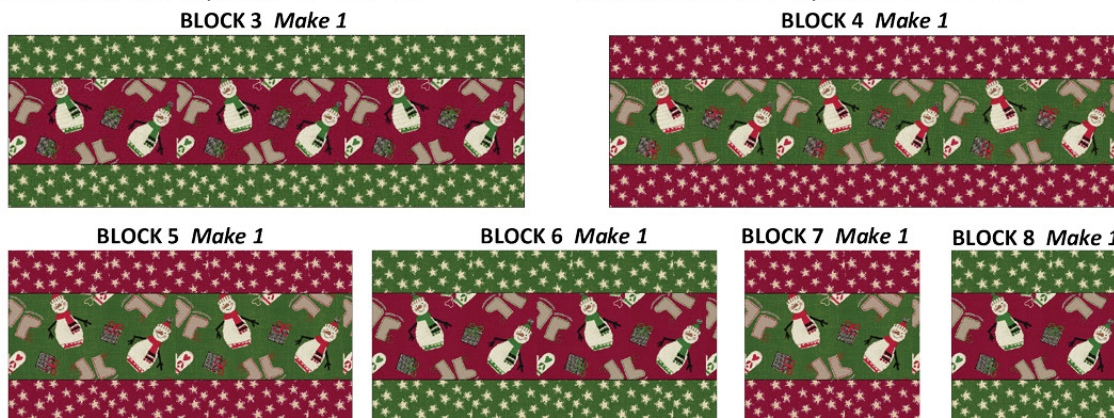
BLOCKS 1 and 2:

5. Sew (1) UNIT 1 to each side of (1) C 5-1/2" square, then sew (1) UNIT 2 to top and bottom to create BLOCK 1. Square to 10-1/2", make (2).
6. Sew (1) UNIT 3 to each side of (1) C 5-1/2" square, then sew (1) UNIT 4 to top and bottom to create BLOCK 2. Square to 10-1/2", make (2).



BLOCKS 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8:

7. Sew strips together listed noted below to create blocks. Square to size indicated, make (1) each .

| BLOCK 5: (10-1/2" X 20-1/2"): G2 - A2 - G2 | BLOCK 6: (10-1/2" X 20-1/2"): F2 - B2 - F2 |
| BLOCK 7: (10-1/2" square): G3 - A3 - G3 | BLOCK 8: (10-1/2" square): F3 - B3 - F3 |

Assembly Instructions (Refer to quilt cover image for proper placement and rotation of blocks)

Quilt Assembly:

8. Sew blocks together in rows, then sew rows together with D SASHING strips between each row.

Row 1: Block 1 - Block 3

Row 2: Block 7 - Block 2 - Block 5

Row 3: Block 6 - Block 1 - Block 8

Row 4: Block 4 - Block 2

Border Assembly:

Border #1

9. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 48"), cut (2) D 3" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 45-1/2") cut (2) D 3" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Border #2

10. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 53"), cut (2) E 3" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 50-1/2") cut (2) E 3" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Finishing:

Backing and batting should be 8" larger than finished quilt top. Layer your backing, batting and quilt top, then quilt as desired. Bind using your preferred method ... and enjoy!
