**Cutting Notes:** Mark and store your cutting pieces according to the block they have been assigned to, as this will make it much easier when you start piecing. Be sure to read the entire pattern before you begin. Appliqué techniques required.

#### **Additional Requirements:**

- Fusible webbing to adhere fabric pieces to blocks
- Glue Pen (recommended) to keep small pieces from shifting until appliqued to larger pieces
- Matching thread for each appliqué piece or color of your choice
- Embroidery thread in White and Black colors
- Fabric marking pen (for marking around each template)
- Parchment paper, Teflon non- stick pad or large coffee filter for pressing cloth
- Bleach White Batting face print is white so the top of quilt will not change color

#### **Special Notes:**

- All seam allowances are 1/4".
- All templates are straight cut with no seam allowance as they are to be appliquéd with a tight zigzag or other desired stitch. Templates are shown in reverse for tracing onto fusible web.
- Follow all manufacturer's recommended instructions for glue pens and fusible webbing for adhering pieces to applique.

#### **Constructing Quilt Blocks**

- 1. Trace templates onto paper side of fusible web and cut out 1/4" past lines. Label each template with piece name. Templates are marked with the fabric 'letter' in RED to be sure you are cutting from the correct color. Sort into piles indicated by fabric color.
- 2. Fuse roughly cut templates on fusible web to the wrong side of indicated fabric. Always follow manufacturer's recommended instructions for using their products. The parchment, teflon non-stick pad or coffee filter can work as a pressing cloth to protect your iron and ironing board as you fuse.
- 3. Cut out all shapes. Fuse smaller detail pieces onto large face pieces, using pressing cloth as you work. Refer to the placement guide for each block on the template sheet. Tip: For small pieces, like eyeballs, whiskers and markings, you might want to use a glue pen to tack them in place so they don't slip. Fuse faces, apple pieces, and rainbow pieces onto 12-1/2" **J** squares, centering each motif.
- 4. To appliqué stitch each block, it is easier to stack the (12) blocks and work down the stack as you machine appliqué each color. You will be working on parts of each animal face, rainbow or apple as you go along. This way keeps you from having to constantly change the thread color. Use a zigzag stitch of your desired thickness.

Note: Since they are fun faces you can feel free to improvise how they look as a personal option!





Using the white color thread as an example:


- Panda appliqué white eyeballs
- Rainbow appliqué white dots
- Fox appliqué the white forehead markings
- Frog appliqué the white eyes
- Cat appliqué white eyeballs and white whiskers
- Mouse appliqué white eyes
- Repeat this same process for each color thread you use.
- 5. Repeat this same process for each color thread you use.
- **6.** Embroidery the mouth of the panda, bunny, cat, tiger and lion are all embroidered using a chain stitch. All require black embroidery thread except that cat uses white.
- 7. Once all (12) blocks have been completed then arrange them in (4) rows of (3) blocks each following the quilt picture. Sew the blocks together first in each row, then sew each row together and press.


#### **Finishing**


- 8. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich.
- 9. Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired.
- **10.** Bind with **Fabric D** strips to finish quilt.




























