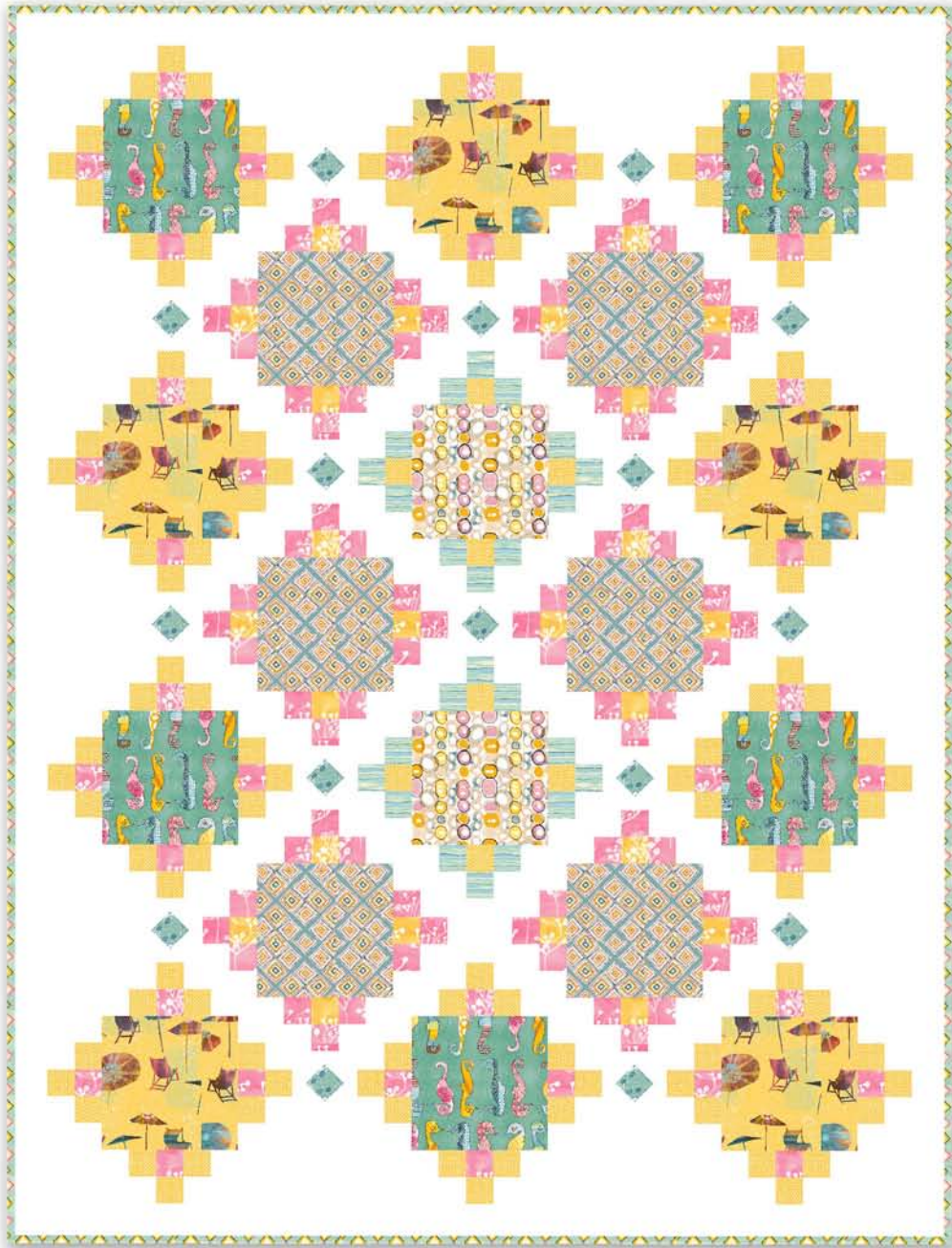

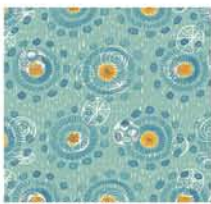

Materials Required

- 2 yards 31835 White solid for background
- 3/8 yards 40665-2 Yellow for accent squares
- 3/8 yard 40663-1 Pink for accent squares
- 1/2 yard 40662-5 Turquoise for feature squares
- 1/4 yard 40657-X Multi for feature squares
- 1/4 yard 40658-2 Yellow for feature squares
- 1/4 yard 40659-4 White for feature square
- 1/8 yard 40660-5 Turquoise for sash accent squares
- 1/8 yard 40663-2 Yellow for accent squares
- 1/8 yard 40664-5 Turquoise for accent squares
- 2 3/4 yards 40661-5 Turquoise for binding and backing
- 53"x 67" piece of Warm and White batting

Cutting

From the White Solid cut:

- 3 squares, 14"x 14" sub cut on both diagonals to make 12 QST's (there will be two extra)
- 2 squares, 7 1/4"x 7 1/4" sub cut on the diagonal to make 4 HST's
- 48 rectangles, 1 3/4"x 9 1/2"
- 76 squares, 3"x 3", sub cut on both diagonals to make 304 QST's (there will be two extra)
- 36 squares, 1 3/4"x 1 3/4", sub cut on the diagonal to make 72 HST's

From the 40665-2 Yellow cut:

- 40 squares, 1 3/4"x 1 3/4"
- 4 strips, 1 3/4"x WOF
- 1 strip, 1 3/4"x 21"



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From the 40663-1 Pink cut:

24 squares, 1 3/4"x 1 3/4"

4 strips, 1 3/4"x WOF

from the 40662-5 Turquoise cut:

6 squares, 6 7/8"x 6 7/8"

From the 40657-X Multi and 40658-2 Yellow cut:

5 squares, 6 7/8"x 6 7/8"

From the 40659-4 White cut:

2 squares, 6 7/8"x 6 7/8"

From the 40660-5 Turquoise fussy cut:

17 squares, 1 3/4"x 1 3/4" with the suns in the center

From the 40663-2 Yellow

1 strip, 1 3/4"x WOF

40664-5 Turquoise cut :

1 strip, 1 3/4"x WOF cut in half

8 squares, 1 3/4"x 1 3/4"

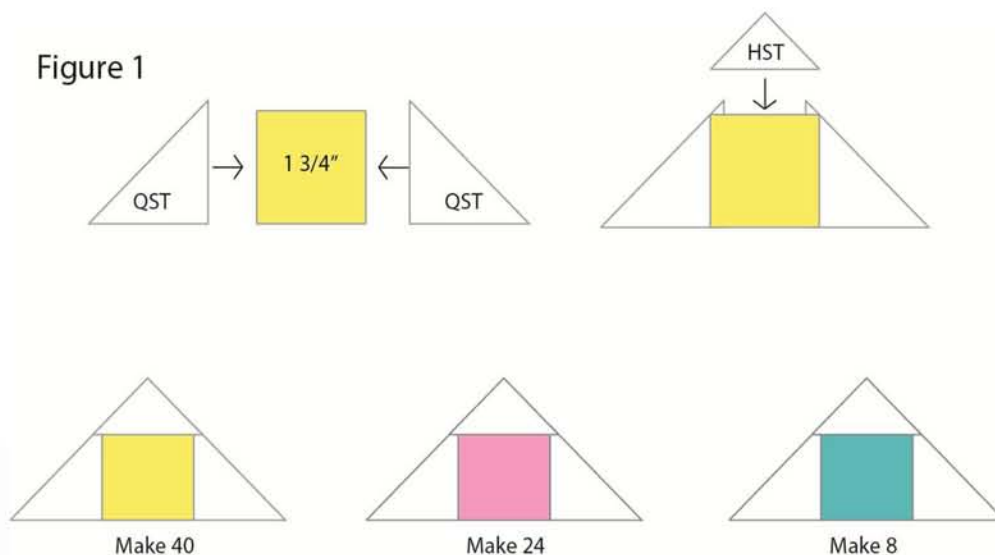
From the 40661-5 Turquoise cut:

6 strips, 2 1/4"xWOF for binding

Use remaining fabric to make a backing piece 53"x67"

Instructions

1. Take the forty 40665-2 Yellow squares, twenty-four 40663-1 Pink squares, and eight 40664-5 Turquoise squares and sew a 3" White QST to either side. Press towards the square, and then sew a 1 3/4" White HST to the top as shown. Trim the extra bits from the seam allowance and press towards the HST.



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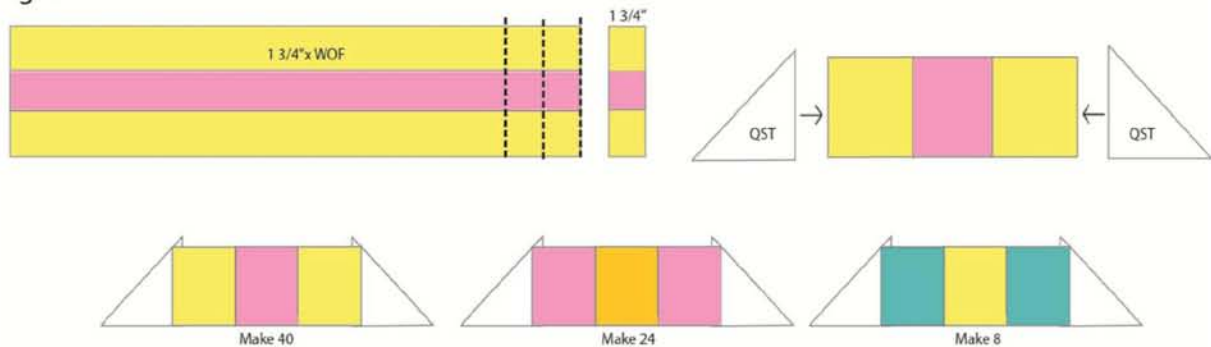
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2. Sew the four 40665-2 Yellow $1\frac{3}{4}$ "x WOF strips to either side of two of the 40663-1 Pink $1\frac{3}{4}$ "x WOF strips, to make 2 Yellow/Pink strip sets. Press towards the Yellow. From the strip sets cut 40 rectangles $1\frac{3}{4}$ " wide. Sew a 3" White QST to either end of each piece as before.

3. Sew the two remaining 40663-1 Pink $1\frac{3}{4}$ "x WOF strips to either side of the 40663-2 Yellow $1\frac{3}{4}$ "x WOF strip. Press towards the Pink and cut 24 rectangles $1\frac{3}{4}$ " wide from the strip set. Sew a 3" White QST to either end of each piece as before.

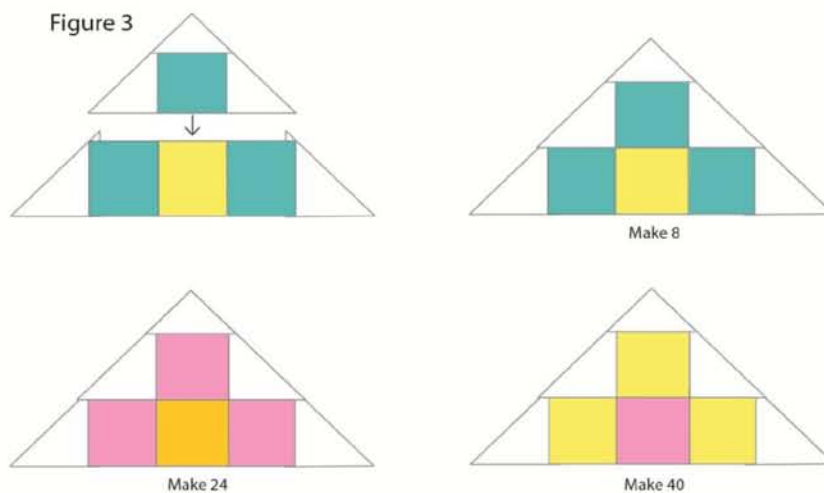
4. Sew the two 40664-5 Turquoise $1\frac{3}{4}$ "x 21" strips to either side of the 40665-2 Yellow $1\frac{3}{4}$ "x 21" strip. Press towards the Turquoise and cut 8 rectangles $1\frac{3}{4}$ " wide from the strip set. Sew a 3" White QST to either end of each piece as before.

5. Sew the pieces from step one to the top of the pieces from steps two through four, matching the center squares of each piece and nesting the seams, to make the frame pieces as shown. Trim the extra bits from the seam allowances and press up towards the top.

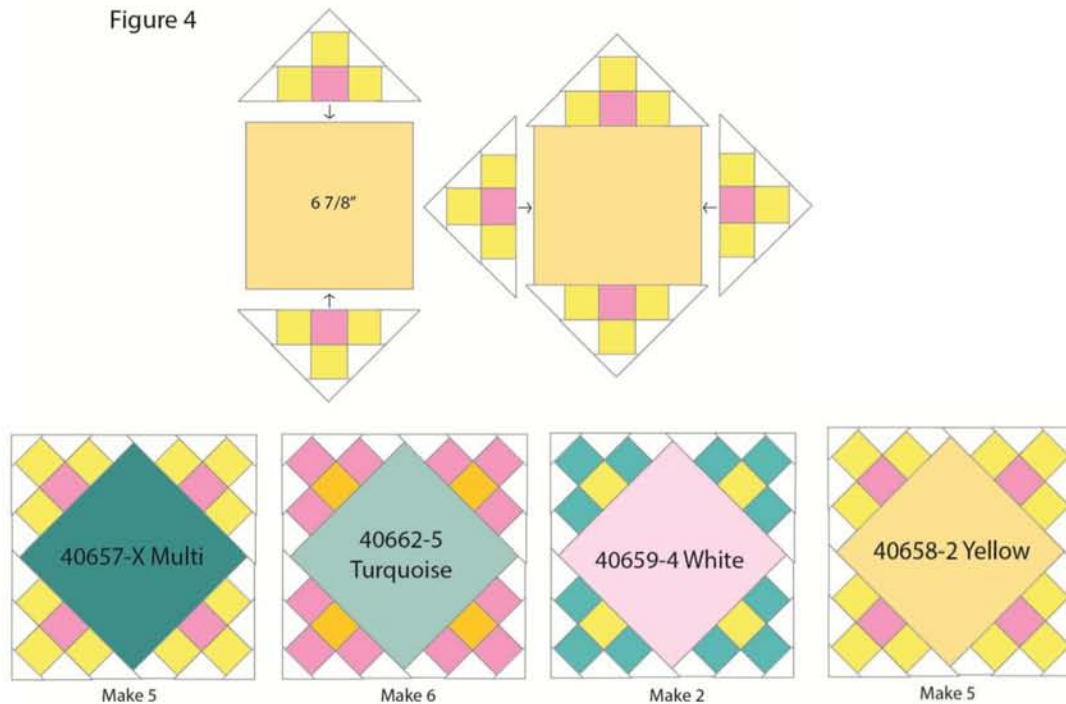
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6. Sew a pair of 40665-2 Yellow frames to opposite sides of the 40657-X Multi and 40658-2 Yellow 6 7/8" squares. Press towards the squares, then sew a second pair of 40665-2 Yellow frames to the remaining sides of the square. Press towards the square, trim the block to 9 1/2"x 9 1/2". Repeat for the 40663-1 Pink frames and 40662-5 Turquoise squares, and the 40664-5 Turquoise frames and 40659-4 White squares to make 18 Framed Blocks.

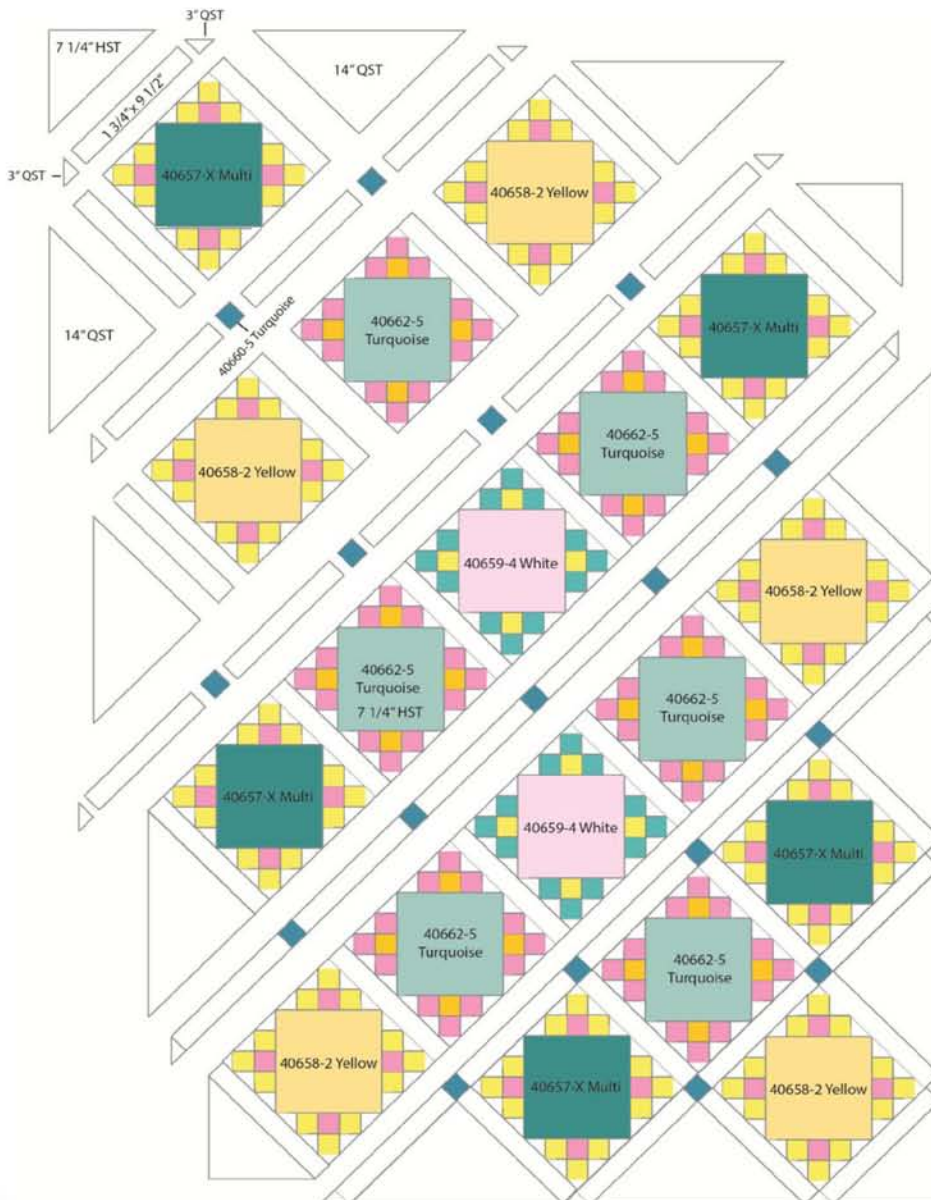


7. Sew a white 1 3/4"x9 1/2" strip to one side of each Framed Block. Using the layout chart provided, sew the Framed Blocks, remaining white HST's, QST's, rectangles, and the 40660-5 Turquoise squares together into diagonal rows of blocks and sashes, paying careful attention to the orientation of the end triangles of the sashes and block rows. Sew the diagonal rows together, matching all seams and paying careful attention to the diagram for proper placement of diagonal rows, to finish the quilt top.

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8. Layer and baste the backing, batting, and quilt top. Quilt as desired. Sew the 40661-5 Turquoise strips together using a diagonal seam to make the binding. Fold the binding in half wrong sides together and press. Sew the binding to the front of the finished quilt, turn it to the back and hand or machine stitch it in place. Add a label, sit back, and enjoy!



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
