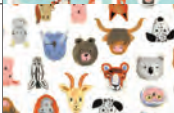


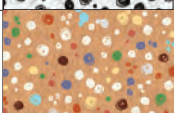

C		52932-10 Terracotta INCLUDES BINDING	3/4	(1) 7-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (3) 6" x 7-1/2" rectangles. BINDING: (6) 2-1/4" x WOF strips.
D		52975-1 Sky	1/2	(1) 13-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (2) 10-1/2" x 13-1/2" and (2) 6" x 7-1/2" rectangles.

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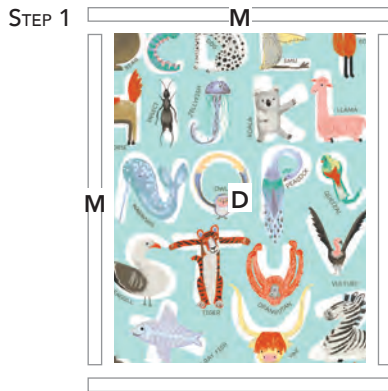

M		52782-46 White on White	1	<p>(3) 1" x WOF strips; subcut (4) 1" x 11-1/2" and (4) 1" x 13-1/2" rectangles.</p> <p>(6) 1-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (14) 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" and (7) 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles.</p> <p>SASHING: (5) 1-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (6) 1-1/2" x 15-1/2" rectangles and (2) 1-1/2" x 38-1/2" strips.</p> <p>OUTER BORDER: (3) 1-3/4" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 1-3/4" x 47-1/2" strips.</p> <p>(2) 3" x WOF strips; subcut (2) 3" x 41" strips.</p>

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BLOCK A

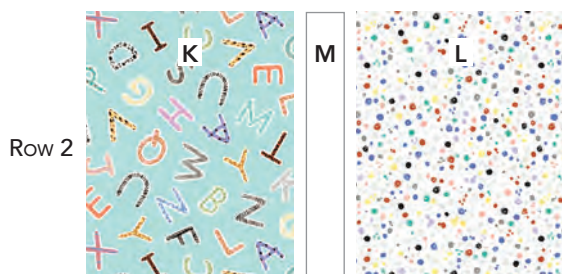
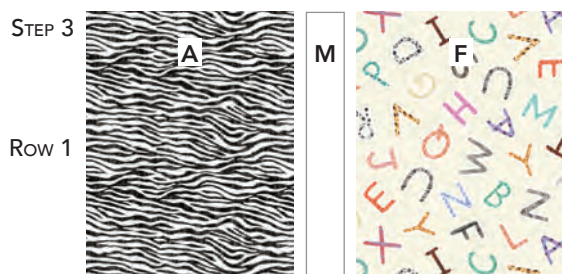
1. Sew (2) **M** 1" x 13-1/2" rectangles to the opposite long sides of (1) **D** 10-1/2" x 13-1/2" rectangle, followed by sewing (2) **M** 1" x 11-1/2" rectangles to the top and bottom of **D**.
2. Sew (2) **B** 1" x 14-1/2" rectangles to the opposite long sides of **Step 1** unit, followed by (2) **B** 1" x 12-1/2" rectangles to the top and bottom of same unit to complete (1) **Block A**. Make (2). Block measures 12-1/2" x 15-1/2" unfinished.



BLOCK B

REFER TO QUILT IMAGE FOR FABRIC PLACEMENT GUIDE.

3. Sew (2) 6" x 7-1/2" print rectangles to the opposite long sides of (1) **M** 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangle, as shown below, to make a row unit. Make (2).
4. Sew row units to the opposite long sides of (1) **M** 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle to complete (1) **Block B**. Make (7).





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QUILT ASSEMBLY - REFER TO QUILT IMAGE FOR FABRIC PLACEMENT GUIDE.

5. Sew together Blocks A and B and (2) **M** 1-1/2" x 15-1/2" rectangles to make a pieced row. Make (3).
6. Sew pieced rows together, alternating with (2) **M** 1-1/2" x 38-1/2" strips to complete quilt center.
7. **Outer Border:** Sew (2) **M** 1-3/4" x 47-1/2" strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) **M** 3" x 41" strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **C** 2-1/4" strips.
