



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Supplies:

3/8y: green trellis (42088-3 Green)

3/8y: red puppy (42087-1 Red)

3/8y: yellow kitten (42090-4 Yellow)

3/8y: blue puppy (42087-2 Blue)

1/4y: green toss (42091-3 Green)

1/4y: red trellis (42088-1 Red)

1/2 y: blue toss (42091-2 Blue) includes binding

1/4y: yellow trellis (42088-4 Yellow)

1 1/8y: white solid flannel *Not pictured in skus above*

3 yards of backing fabric

50" square piece of batting

Basic sewing supplies

Cutting Instructions:

From each of the 42088-3 Green, 42087-1 Red, 42090-4 Yellow and 42087-2 Blue prints, cut: 3 (3 1/2" x 42") strips, then cut into 9 (3 1/2" x 6 1/2") rectangles and 9 (3 1/2" x 3 1/2") squares

From the 42091-3 Green print:

1 (2-3/8" x 42") strip; then cut into 9 (2 3/8" x 2 3/8") squares and 9 (2" x 2") squares

From the 42088-1 Red print:

1 (2 $3/8" \times 42"$) strip; then cut into 9 (2 $3/8" \times 2 3/8"$) squares and 9 (2" x 2") squares 1 (1 $1/2" \times 1 1/2"$) square

From the 42091-2 Blue print:

1 (2 3/8" x 42") strip; then cut into 9 (2 3/8" x 2 3/8") squares and 9 (2" x 2") squares 5 (2 1/4" x 42") strips for binding 1 (1 1/2" x 1 1/2") square

From the 42088-4 Yellow print:

1 (2 3/8" x 42") strip; then cut into 9 (2 3/8" x 2 3/8") squares and 9 (2" x 2") squares 2 (1 1/2" x 1 1/2") squares

From the white solid:

3 (2 3/8" x 42") strips; then cut into 36 (2 3/8" x 2 3/8") squares 3 (2" x 42") strips; then cut into 36 (2" x 2") squares 4 (1 1/2" x 42") strips; then cut into 12 (1 1/2" x 12 1/2") rectangles 5 (3 1/2" x 42") strips for outer border 1 (1 1/2" x 1 1/2") square

Constructing Pieced Blocks

1. Block Quadrant. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 1 (2 3/8" x 2 3/8") white solid square. Place square, right sides together, on 1 (2 3/8" x 2 3/8") yellow trellis square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line. Open and press to yield 2 HST units.




Sew 2 HST units, 1 (2" x 2") red trellis square and 1 (2" x 2") white solid square to make a four-patch unit.






Add 1 (3 1/2" x 3 1/2") red puppy square to the top of the four-patch unit, followed by 1 (3 1/2" x 6 1/2") blue puppy rectangle to the left to complete 1 block quadrant.




2. Repeat process to construct the remaining 3 quadrants, referring to the fabric placements as shown.







3. Sew quadrants together to complete 1 block.



4. Repeat to make a total of 9 blocks.


Quilt Top Assembly

1. Pieced Rows. Sew 3 pieced blocks and 2 (1 1/2" x 12 1/2") white solid sashing rectangles to make a pieced row.





2. Pieced Sashing Rows (SR). Sew 3 (1 1/2" x 12 1/2") white tonal sashing rectangles and 2 (1 1/2" x 1 1/2") sashing squares to make a pieced sashing row.

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3. Sew pieced rows and pieced sashing rows together to complete quilt center.



4. Trim 2 (3 1/2" x 42") white strips to 38 1/2" long. Sew remaining 3 (3 1/2" x 42") white strips short ends short ends together and cut 2 (44 1/2") lengths. Outer border. Sew 2 (3 1/2" x 38 1/2") white solid strips to the opposite sides of quilt center. Sew 2 (3 1/2" x 44 1/2") white solid strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.

Quilting Instructions:

With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired. Bind using 5 (2 1/4" x 42") blue toss print strips to finish the quilt.
