B		50307-1	7/8	<p>Border #6 (8) 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 3-1/2" x 66-1/2" and (2) 3-1/2" x 72-1/2" strips.</p>
C		50308-1	3/8	<p>Border #2 (1) 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (16) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces. Border #3 (1) 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (8) 4-1/2" squares.</p>

Subcut (4) 1-1/2" x 36-1/2" and (4) 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" pieces, and (4) 1-1/2" squares. Border #2 and #3 (2) 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (16) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces and (8) 4-1/2" squares. (9) 2-1/4" x WOF strips for binding.</p>



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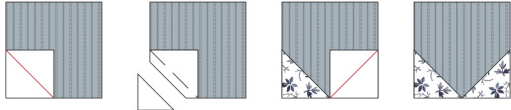

Subcut (176) 2-1/2" squares.</p> <p>Border #3 (14) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (224) 2-1/2" squares.</p> <p>Border #4 (7) 3-1/2" x WOF strips. 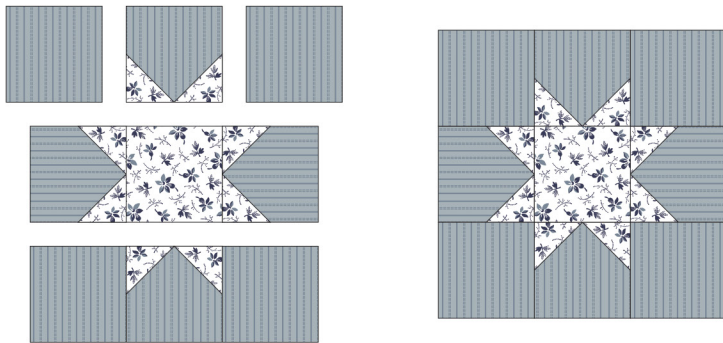
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Making the Star Blocks

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side for (1) 1-1/2" **D** square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) 2-1/2" **O** square. Sew on drawn line, trim 1/4" away from the line, and press open. Repeat with another 1-1/2" **D** square on an adjoining corner to complete (1) star point unit. Make a total of (4) star point units.



2. Sew star point units to the opposite sides of (1) 2-1/2" **D** square to make the block center row. Sew 2-1/2" **O** squares to opposite sides of (1) star point unit. Make (2) side rows. Sew the side rows to the block center row to complete a 6-1/2" **D/O** star block.

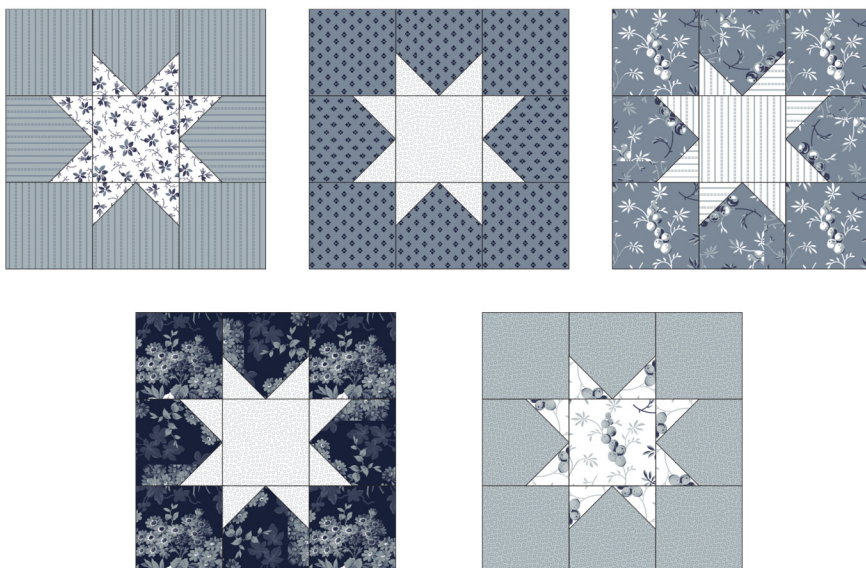


3. For the quilt center, make the indicated number of blocks using each fabric combination:

7 blocks: **D/O, I/L**

6 blocks: **N/G, I/A**

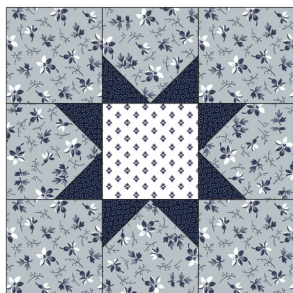
4 blocks: **F/J**





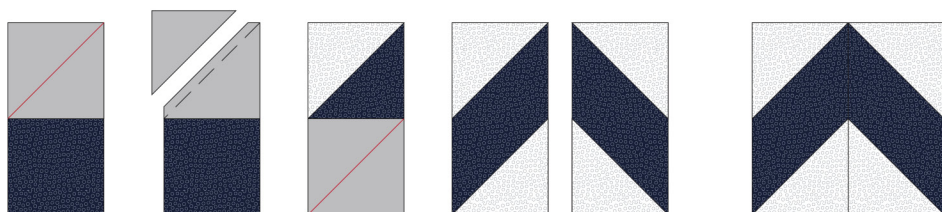
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4. In the same way, make a total of (6) blocks using **K** for the center square, **H** for the star points, and **E** for the background.



Making Chevron Sections

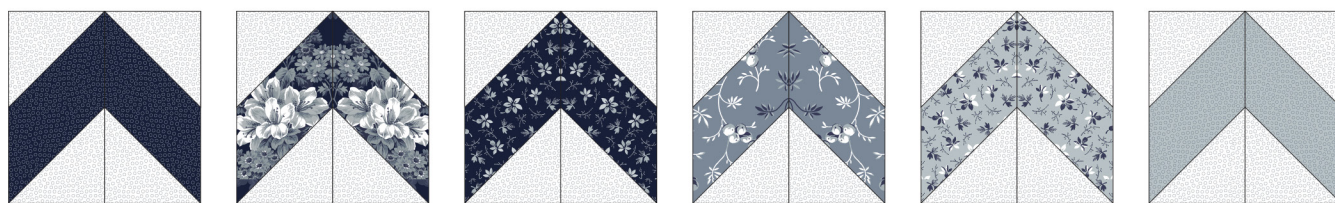
5. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2-1/2" **I** square. Noting orientation, place square, right sides together, on the end of (1) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" **H** piece. Sew on drawn line, trim 1/4" away from line, and press open. Repeat with a second 2-1/2" **I** square at the opposite end to complete a parallelogram unit. Repeat to make a mirror-image parallelogram unit. Sew the units together to complete a 4-1/2" square chevron unit.



6. In the same way, make the indicated number of chevron units using the indicated fabrics:

(8) chevron units: **H, A, C, G, E**

(4) chevron units: **J**



7. Arrange and sew together (5) chevron units to make a row unit in this order: **H, A, C, G, E**. Make a total of (4) chevron sections and (4) chevron sections in reverse.

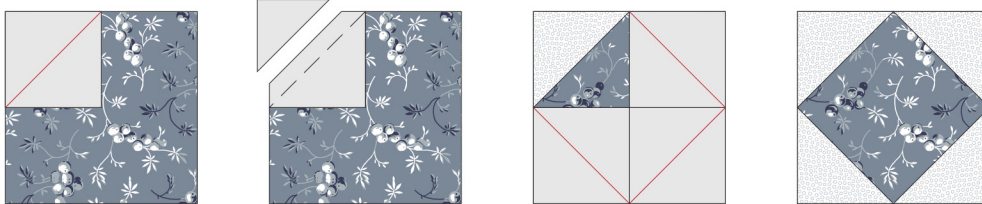




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Square-in-a-Square Units

8. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2-1/2" **I** square. Place marked square, right sides together, on a corner of (1) 4-1/2" **G** square. Sew on drawn line trim 1/4" away from the line and press open. Repeat 2-1/2" **I** squares on the remaining corners to complete (1) square-in-a-square unit.

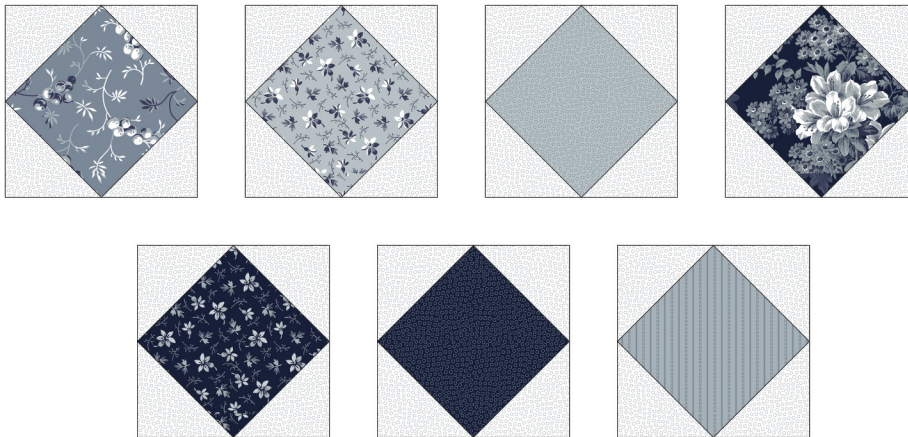


9. In the same way, make the indicated number of square-in-a-square units using the indicated fabrics:

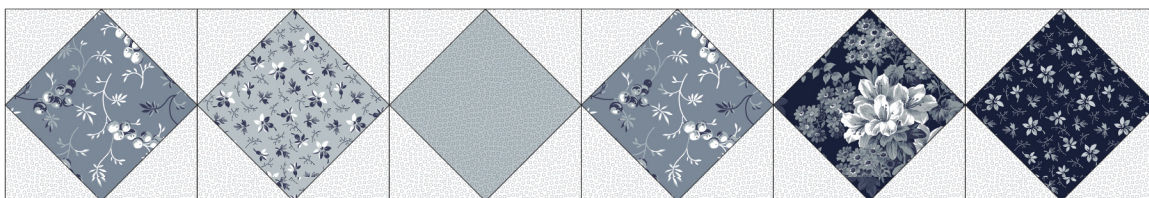
16 units: **G**

8 units: **E, J, A, C**

4 units: **H, O**



10. Arrange and sew together (6) square-in-a-square unit to make a square-in-a-square section. Make a total of (4) sections and (4) sections in reverse.



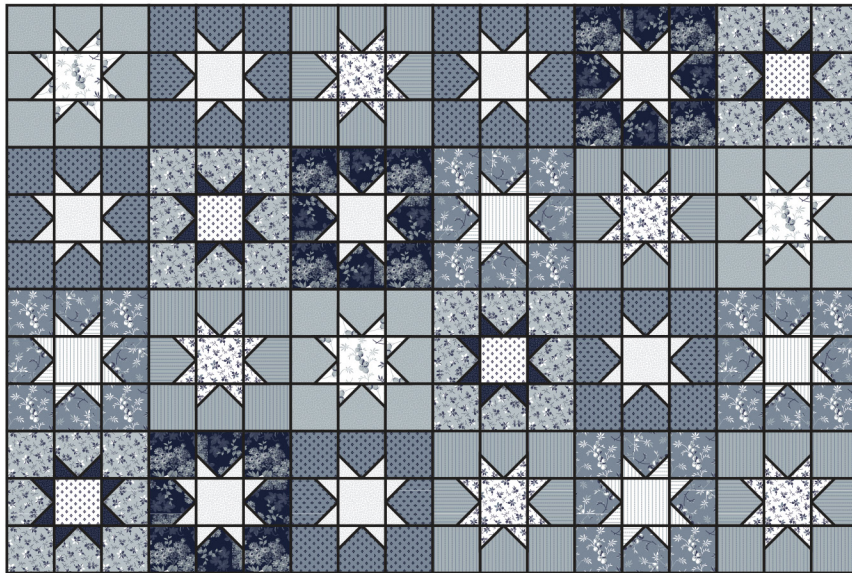
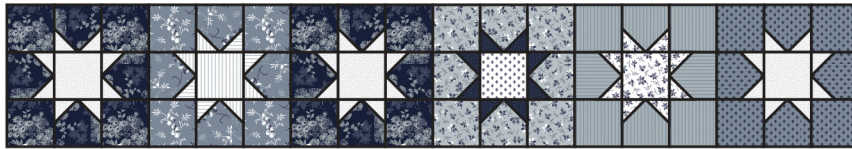
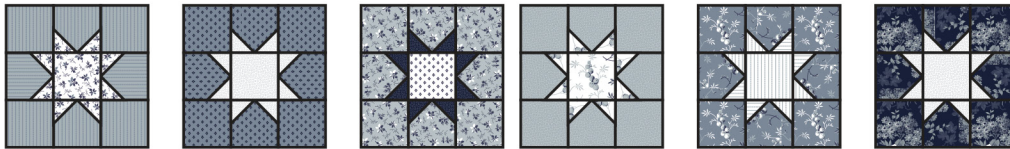


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Quilt Assembly

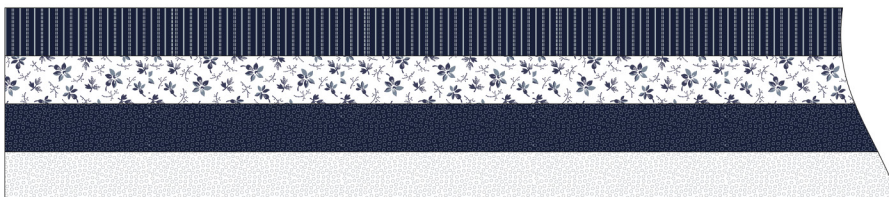
Note: Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram on page 8 as you assemble the quilt.

11. Lay out the center star blocks in (6) rows of (6) blocks each. Sew the blocks into rows and join the rows to complete the quilt center.



12.

Sew together 1-1/2" x 36-1/2" **I, H, D, M** strips lengthwise to make a pieced border strip. Make a total of (4) pieced border strips.

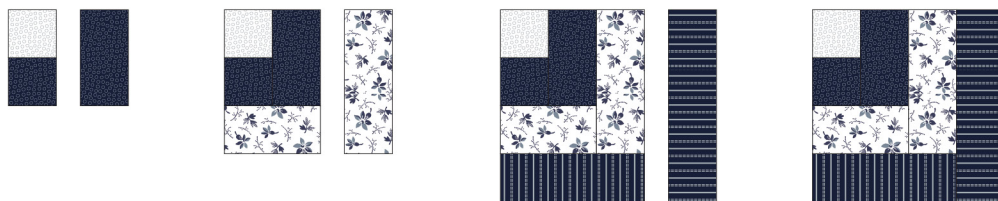




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13. Sew pieced border strips to opposite sides of the quilt center.

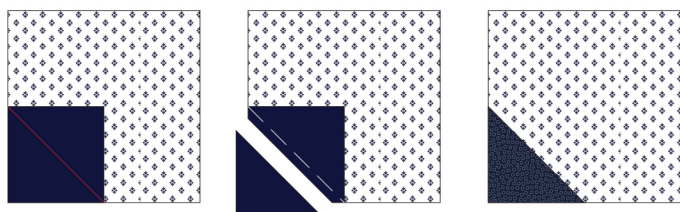
14. Corner units. Sew (1) 1-1/2" **I** square and (1) 1-1/2" **H** square together. Add (1) 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" **H** piece to the right side. Add (1) 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" **D** piece to the bottom, followed by (1) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" **D** piece to the right. Add (1) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" **M** piece to the bottom, followed by (1) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" **M** piece to the right to complete (1) corner unit. Make a total of (4) corner units.



15. Sew corner units to the opposite short ends of a pieced border unit. Make (2). Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt center.

16. **Border #2.** Sew (1) chevron section and (1) chevron section in reverse to opposite sides of (1) **J** chevron unit to make a pieced chevron border. Make a total of (4) pieced chevron borders.

17. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2-1/2" **H** square. Place square, right sides together, on a corner of (1) 4-1/2" **I** square. Sew on drawn line, trim 1/4" from line, and press open. Make a total of (4) corner units.



18. Sew corner units to opposite short ends of (1) pieced chevron border. Make (2). Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.

19. Sew one square-in-a-square section and (1) reverse section to opposite sides of (1) **H** square-in-a-square unit to make a row. Make (4) rows. Sew (2) rows to opposite sides of the quilt. Sew **O** square-in-a-square units to opposite ends of the remaining (2) rows and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.

20. **Border #3.** Sew 3-1/2" x 60-1/2" **I** strips to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by 3-1/2" x 65-1/2" **I** strips to the top and bottom.



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- 21. Border #4.** Sew (2) 3-1/2" x 66-1/2" **B** strips to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by 3-1/2" x 72-1/2" **B** strips to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.
22. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste and then quilt as desired.
23. Use the (9) 2-1/4" x WOF **H** strips to bind the quilt.
