



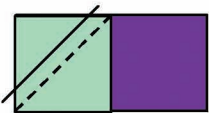

Piecing Instructions

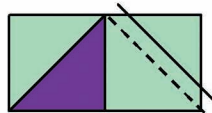
Blocks 1 and 2:

1. Take (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " C square and either fold diagonally and press with iron or draw diagonal line on the wrong side. Place C square right sides together on one side of G $3\frac{1}{2}$ " X $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle and sew on diagonal line. Press with seam allowance towards the G (darker) fabric. Trim excess fabric on reverse side to $\frac{1}{4}$ ".
2. Repeat step 1 with remaining side of C rectangle. Make (24) CG units.
3. Sew (2) G $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares to sides of (1) CG unit. Make (12) G-CG-G units.
4. Sew (2) CG units to sides of (1) F $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square, then sew (2) G-CG-G units to top and bottom to create Block 1. Square to $12\frac{1}{2}$ ", make (6).
5. Repeat steps 1-5 using B $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares in place of C $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and E $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square in place of F $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square to create Block 2. Square to $12\frac{1}{2}$ ", make (6).

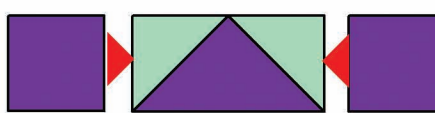

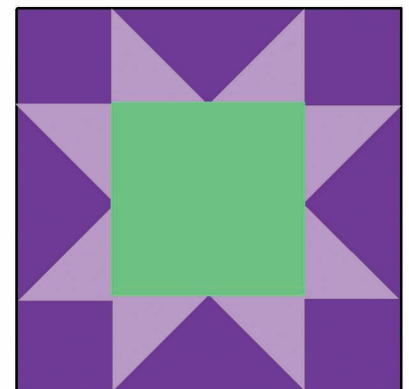
STEP 4 (BLOCK 1)

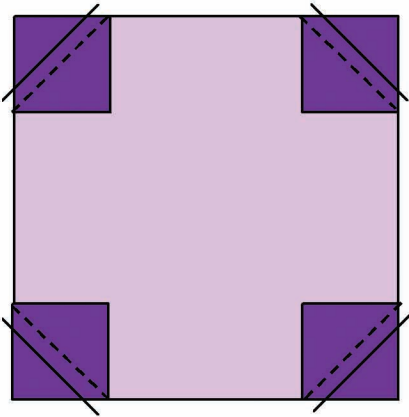
Block 3:

6. Take (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " G square and either fold diagonally and press with iron or draw diagonal line on the wrong side. Place G square right sides together on one side of D $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square and sew on diagonal line. Press with seam allowance towards the G (darker) fabric. Trim excess fabric on reverse side to $\frac{1}{4}$ ".
7. Repeat step 1 with remaining sides of D square to create Block 3, square to $12\frac{1}{2}$ ", make (6).

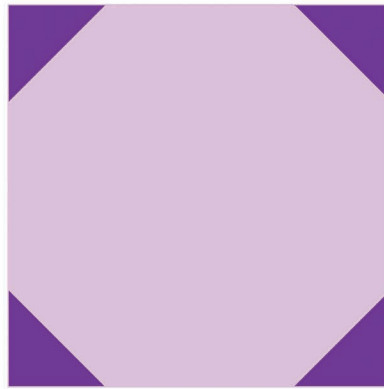

Assembly Instructions

Quilt Assembly: (Refer to cover image for proper placement and rotation of blocks)

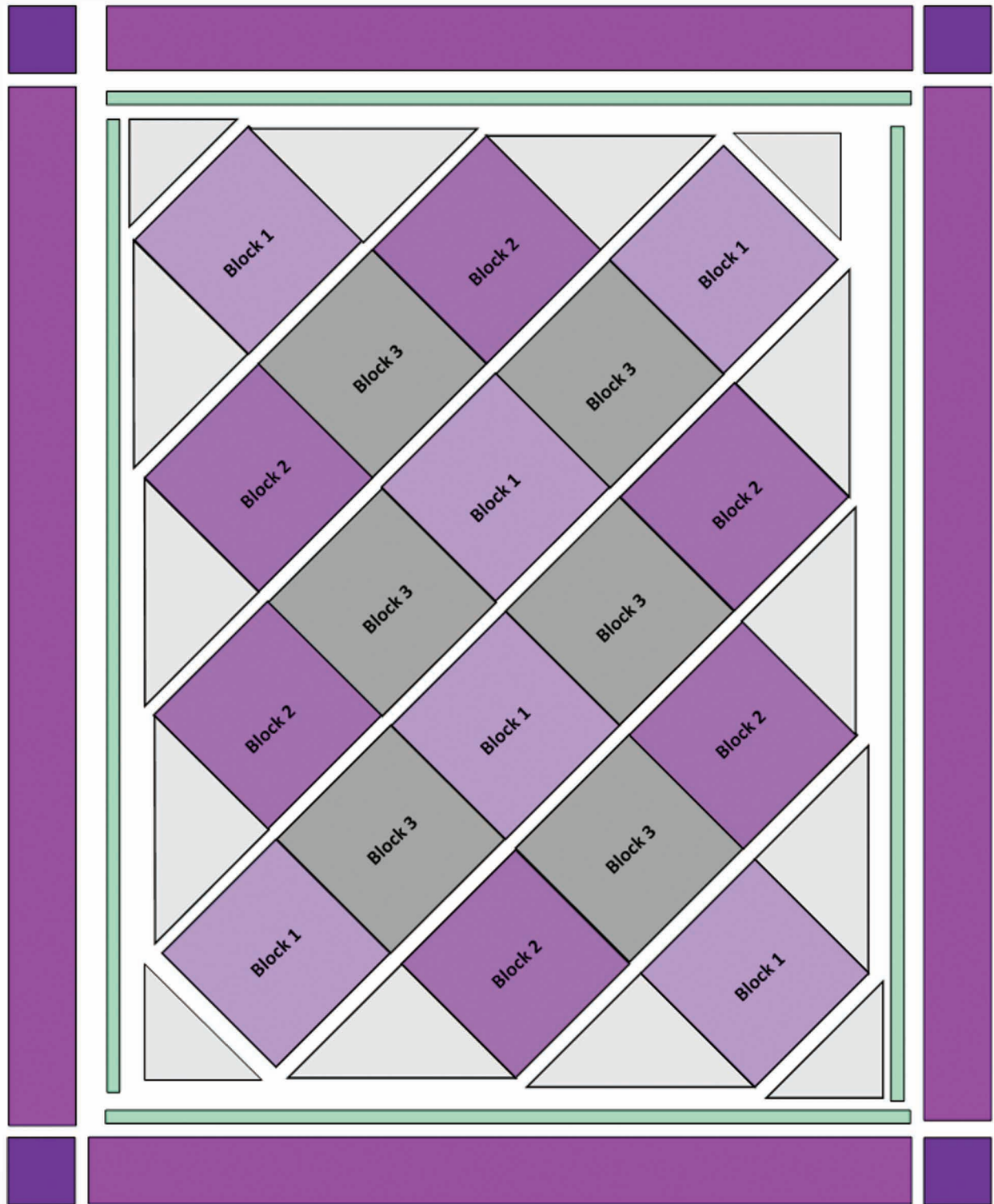
1. Sew the following blocks together into diagonal rows, then sew rows together.
ROWS 1, 6: A SST - Block 1 – A SST
ROWS 2, 5: A SST – Block 2 – Block 3 – Block 2 – A SST
ROW 3, 4: A SST – Block 2 – Block 3 – Block 1 – Block 3 – Block 1.
2. Sew (1) A CST to each corner of quilt, then trim quilt to $\frac{1}{4}$ " beyond the points of blocks.

Border Assembly:

3. Border #1: Sew (7) 1-1/2" C strips together via the short ends using a straight seam. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 68-3/8"), cut (2) strips and sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom (ours is 51-1/2), cut (2) strips and sew to top and bottom of quilt.
4. Border #2: Sew (7) 6-1/2" F strips together via the short ends using a straight seam. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 51-1/2"), cut (2) strips to fit, then sew (1) 6-1/2" G square to each end of strip and set aside. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 70-3/8"), cut (2) strips and sew to sides of quilt. Then sew ACA strips to top and bottom of quilt.
