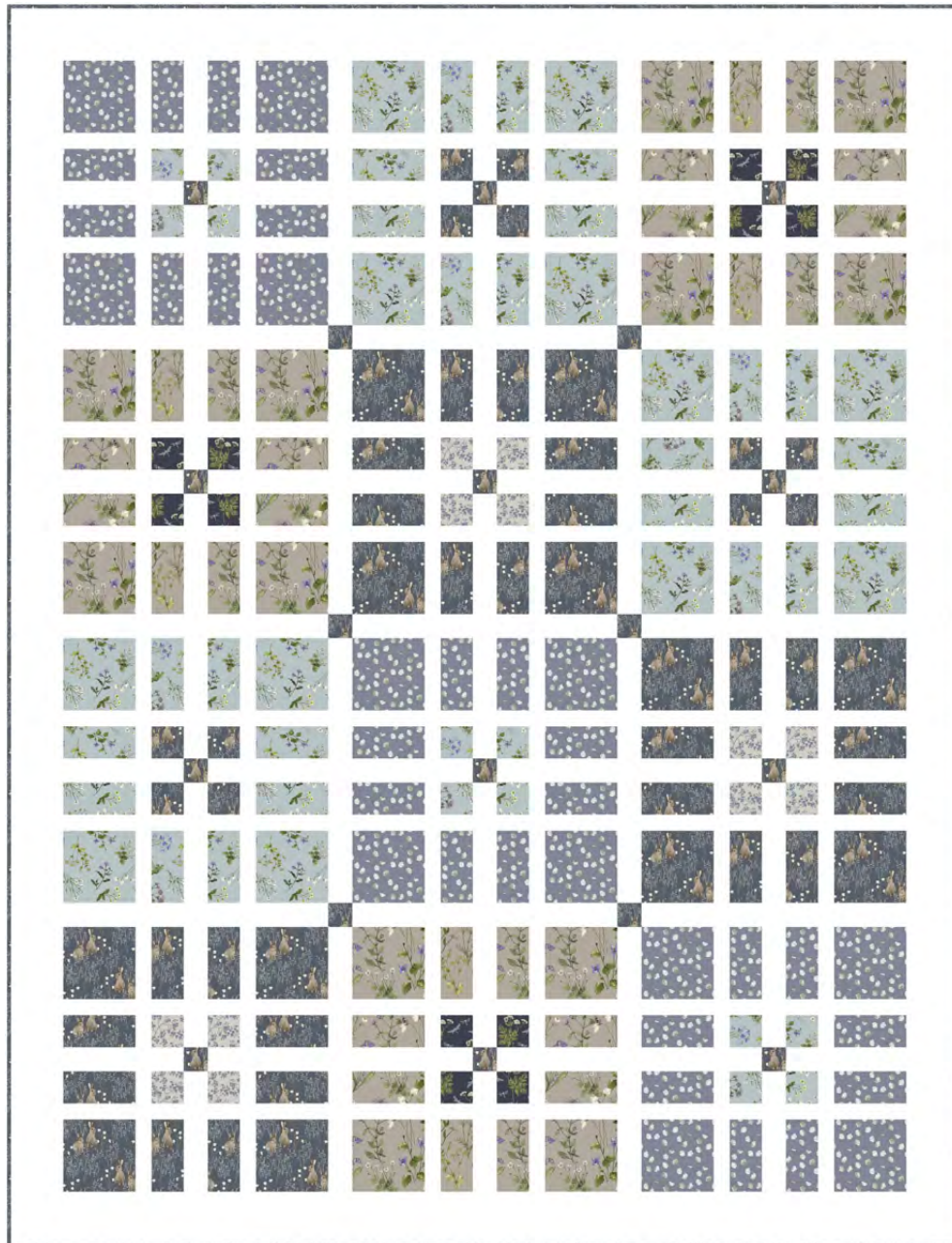

# Window Pane

**Cutting Notes:** Mark and store cut pieces according to the assigned block.  
This will make it much easier to piece.

WOF = Width of Fabric

Piece strips and subcut (2) 3-3/4" x 59-1/2" strips and (2) 3-3/4" x 71" strips.</p> <p><b>SASHING RECTANGLES</b></p> <p>(9) 2" x WOF strips; subcut (17) 2" x 17" rectangles.</p>

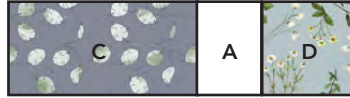

E		52316-3 Stone	5/8	<b>PIECED BLOCKS</b> (3) 5" x WOF strips; subcut (12) 5" squares and (24) 2-1/2" x 5" rectangles.
F		52321-8 Pewter	1/8	<b>PIECED BLOCKS</b> (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (12) 2-1/2" squares.
G		52319-1 Graphite	1/8	<b>PIECED BLOCKS</b> (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (12) 2-1/2" squares.
		Backing	4-3/4	Batting 65" x 83"



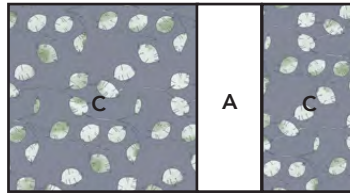

## PIECED BLOCKS

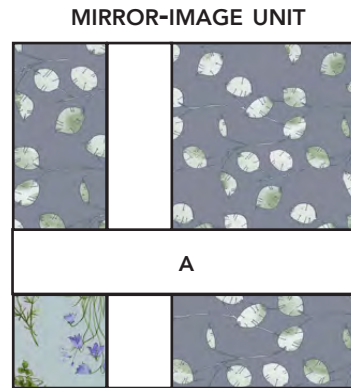
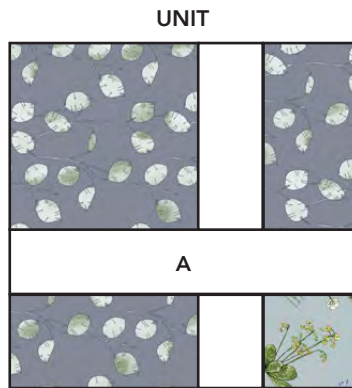
1. Arrange and sew (1) **C** 2-1/2" x 5" rectangle to the left of (1) **A** 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle. Then, sew (1) **D** 2-1/2" square to the right of pieced unit to make a row.



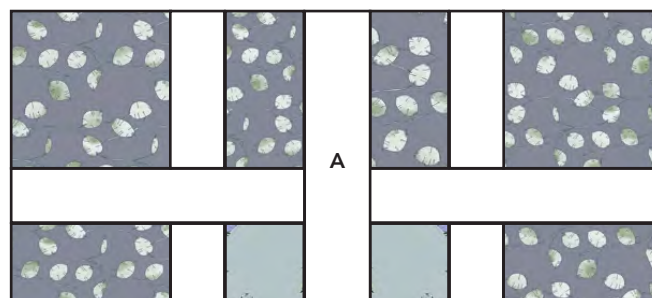
2. Arrange and sew (1) **C** 5" square to the left, (1) **A** 1-1/2" x 5" rectangle in the middle and (1) **C** 2-1/2" x 5" rectangle to the right to make a row.



3. Sew rows made in Steps 1-2 to the opposite long sides of (1) **A** 1-1/2" x 8" rectangle. Repeat to make (2) Units and (2) Mirror-Image Units.



4. Sew (1) Unit and (1) Mirror-Image Unit to the opposite long sides of (1) **A** 2" x 8" rectangle to make a row. Make (2) rows.

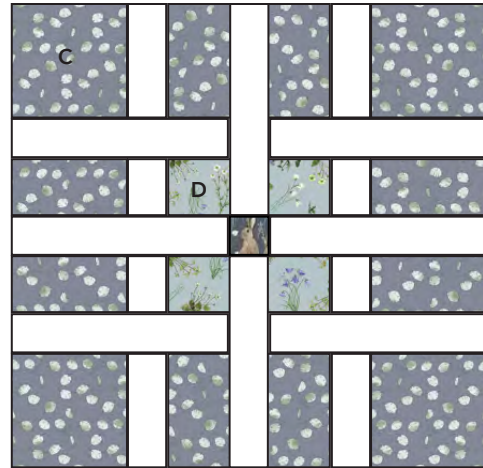
5. Sew (2) 2" x 8" **A** rectangles to opposite sides of (1) 2" **B** square to make a row.
6. Sew rows together to complete (1) 17" square unfinished block. Make (3).

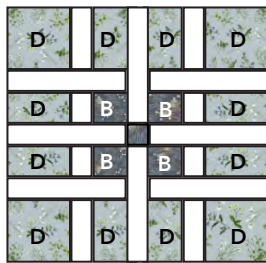

7. Repeat Steps 1-6 to make a total of (12) blocks in the following fabric combinations:

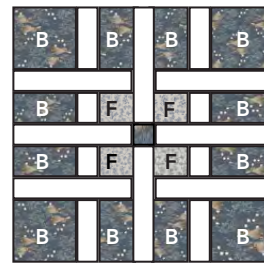
(3) Block D/B

(3) Block B/F

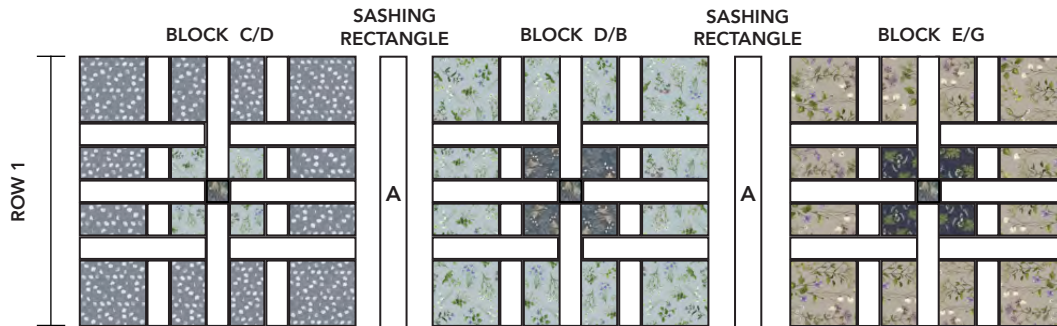

## QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY

8. Refer to the **Quilt Diagram** on page 6. Arrange and sew together (3) pieced blocks and (2) **A** 2" x 17" sashing rectangles to make a pieced row. Repeat to make a total of (4) rows.



9. **Pieced Sashing Rows:** Arrange and sew together (3) **A** 2" x 17" sashing rectangles and (2) **B** 2" squares to make a sashing row. Repeat to make (3) pieced sashing rows.



10. Refer to the **Quilt Diagram** for assembly. Sew pieced and sashing rows together to complete quilt center.

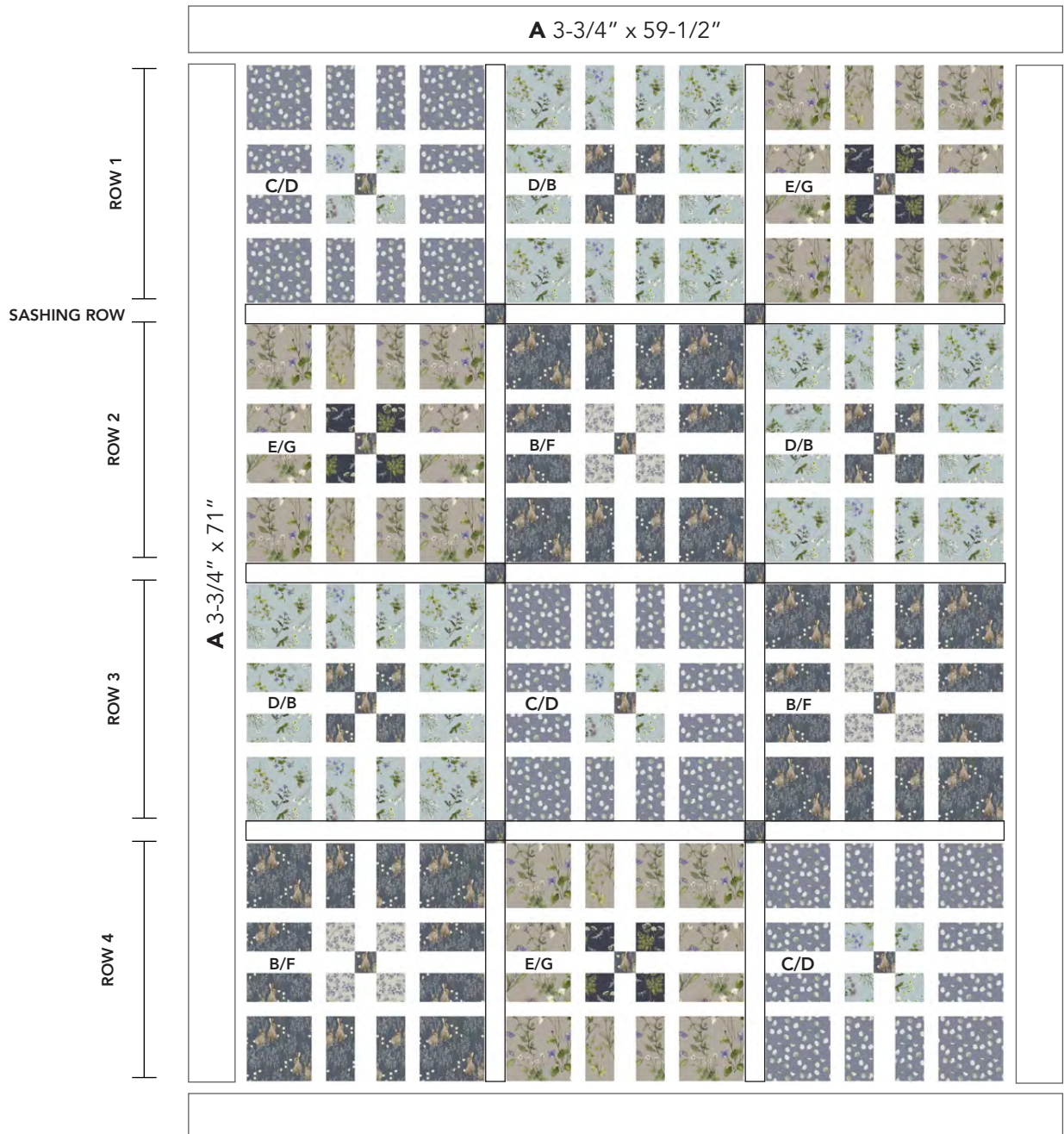
## BORDER

11. Sew (2) **A** 3-3/4" x 71" strips to the sides of quilt center, followed by (2) **A** 3-3/4" x 59-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.

## QUILT DIAGRAM



**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **B**  $2\text{-}1/2"$  strips.
