## Fabric Requirements

3/8 yd panel squares 39003-X

5/8 yd 39004-X for Center Panel

1 1/2 yds Outer Border 39005-2 (to cut lengthwise strips for top and bottom borders)

1/2 yd 39006-1 for Blocks in Pieced Border

1/4 yd 39007-4 for Blocks in Pieced Border

3/4 yd 39008-5 for Inner Borders and binding

1 1/2 yds backing

## Cutting Instructions

From Center Panel fabric (39004-X) cut a rectangle 17" x 20 5/8"

From the Panel (39003-X) fussy cut 8 – 6 1/2" x 7 7/8" rectangles

From the Berries on White (39006-1) cut:

2 – 2 3/4" strips; cut into 8 – 2 3/4" x 7 7/8" rectangles

2 – 3 1/4" strips; cut into 8 – 3 1/4" x 6 1/2" rectangles

From Wood Grain (39007-4) cut:

2 – 2" strips; cut into:

4 – 2" x 7 7/8" rectangles

4 – 2" x 6 1/2" rectangles

From Dark Blue (39008-5) cut:

3 – 1 1/4" strips for First Border

Cut into 2 – 1 1/4" x 20 5/8" strips and 2 – 1 1/4" x 18 1/2" strips

3 – 1 1/2" strips for Third Border

Cut into 2 – 1 1/2" x 37 1/2" strips and 2 – 1 1/2" x 32 1/2" strips

5 – 2 1/2" strips for Binding

From Outer Border (39005-2) cut:

2 – 4" width of fabric strips first, then from the remaining fabric, cut 2 – 4" length of fabric strips

## Piecing Instructions

To make blocks in Pieced Border, make 4 of each block.

Sew an 8 ½” long Berries on White rectangle to both sides of a 8 ½” long Wood Grain rectangle. Press toward the center. Repeat for 6 ½” long rectangles. Both blocks should measure 6 ½” x 8 ½” unfinished.



Begin assembling quilt by adding the 1 ¼” First Border strips to the Center Panel, starting with the long sides. Press away from the center. Then add the top and bottom. Press away from center.

Sew a vertical pieced block to the top and bottom of 2 fussy cut Panel rectangles. Sew these to the sides of the quilt. Sew the horizontal pieced blocks into 2 rows with the remaining fussy cut Panel rectangles. Sew these to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward the First Border.

Sew the 1 ½” Third Border strips to the quilt, beginning with the long sides. Press away from the center. Then add the top and bottom. Press away from center.

Measure the length of your quilt through the center and cut 2 strips this length from the crosswise grain strips. Pin well and sew to the long sides of the quilt. Press away from center.

Repeat by measuring across the width of your quilt and cutting 2 strips this length from the lengthwise grain strips. Pin well and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press away from center.

Quilt, bind and enjoy!
