




Outer border: Widthwise, 6 (4" x 42"). Piece strips and subcut 2 (4" x 50") and 2 (4" x 57") strips.

Constructing Block A (using top left block as example)

- 1. Four patch unit. Sew together 2 (2 $1/2" \times 2 1/2"$) **B** squares and 2 (2 $1/2" \times 2 1/2"$) **C** squares to make a four patch unit.
- 2. Sew 1 (2 1/2" x 4 1/2") $\bf J$ rectangle to the left of four patch unit, followed by 1 (2 1/2" x 6 1/2") $\bf J$ rectangle to the bottom of four patch unit.
- 3. Sew 1 (2" \times 6 1/2") **B** rectangle to the left of sewn unit made in step 2, followed by 1 (2" \times 8") **B** rectangle to the bottom.
- 4. Sew 1 (1" \times 8") **H** rectangle to the left of sewn unit made in step 3, followed by 1 (1" \times 8 1/2") **H** rectangle to the bottom.
- 5. Sew 1 (1 1/2" x 8 1/2") **A** rectangle to the left of sewn unit made in step 4, followed by 1 (1 1/2" x 9 1/2") **A** rectangle to the bottom to complete 1 block.







Constructing Block B (using second row block as example)

- 1. Sew 4 (2 1/2" x 2 1/2") squares to make a four patch unit: two **K**, one **G**, one **H**.
- 2. Sew 1 (1" \times 4 1/2") **H** rectangle to left of four patch unit, followed by 1 (1" \times 5") **H** rectangle to the bottom.
- 3. Sew 1 (2" \times 5") **G** rectangle to the left of sewn unit made step 2, followed by 1 (2" \times 6 1/2") **G** rectangle to the bottom.
- 4. Sew 1 (1 1/2" x 6 1/2") **H** rectangle to the left of sewn unit made step 3, followed by 1 (1 1/2" x 7 1/2") **H** rectangle to the bottom.
- 5. Sew 1 (2 1/2" x 7 1/2") **K** rectangle to the left of sewn unit made in step 4, followed by 1 (2 1/2" x 9 1/2") **K** rectangle to the bottom to complete 1 block.



Quilt Center Assembly

1. Pieced diagonal rows. Arrange and sew together pieced blocks and sashing rectangles, starting from top left diagonal row.

Row 1: Side setting triangle, sashing rectangle, Block C, sashing rectangle, side setting triangle Row 2: Side setting triangle, sashing rectangle, Block E, sashing rectangle, Block I, sashing rectangle, Block D, sashing rectangle, side setting triangle


Row 3: Side setting triangle, sashing rectangle, Block G, sashing rectangle, Block J, sashing rectangle, Block F, sashing rectangle, Block I, sashing rectangle, Block C, sashing rectangle, corner setting triangle

Row 4: Corner setting triangle, sashing rectangle, Block C, sashing rectangle, Block I, sashing rectangle, Block H, sashing rectangle, Block J, sashing rectangle, Block E, sashing rectangle, side setting triangle

Row 5: Side setting triangle, sashing rectangle, Block D, sashing rectangle, Block I, sashing rectangle, Block G, sashing rectangle, side setting triangle

Row 6: Side setting triangle, sashing rectangle, Block C, sashing rectangle, side setting triangle





2. Pieced sashing rows. Arrange and sew together sashing strips and sashing squares, starting from top left diagonal row.

SR 1 & SR 5: 1 (1-1/2" x 32-1/2") **H** sashing strip.

SR 2 & SR 4: 1 (1-1/2" x 31-1/2) $\bf H$ sashing strip, 1 (1-1/2" x 1-1/2") $\bf G$ square, 1 (1-1/2" x 21-1/2") $\bf H$ sashing strip

SR 3: 1 (1-1/2" x 31-1/2") **H** sashing strip, 1 (1-1/2" x 1-1/2") **G** square, 1 (1-1/2" x 31-1/2") **H** strip.

3. Sew pieced diagonal rows and pieced sashing rows together. Add 2 (1 $1/2" \times 12 1/2"$) **H** sashing pieces and then 2 corner setting triangles to the top left and bottom right corners to complete quilt center.

At this point, the side pieces will be "sticking" out, trim around quilt center to include 1/4" seam allowance. At this point, quilt center should measure approximately 43" x 57" raw edge to raw edge. Note rotation of SR 4.

Quilt Top Assembly

1. Outer border. Sew 2 (4" \times 57") **H** strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew 2 (4" \times 50") **H** strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.





Quilting Instructions:

With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired. Bind to finish quilt.
