

1. Make Center Blocks & Rows

Block 1 - Sq to 11 1/2"


- (2) Indigo print strips
- (1) Twilight print strip
- (2) C strips of fabric A



Make 11 total Refer to quilt diagram

Block 2 - Sq to 11 1/2"


- (2) Twilight print strips
- (1) Indigo print strip





Make 7 total Refer to quilt diagram


Piece the blocks together in rows of 3 using the following diagram. Rotate as needed. Use the remaining **C** strips of **fabric A** to separate each block when piecing.





2. Piece Center and Sides

Once each row is finished in Step 1, piece each row together with a **B** strip of **fabric A**. (1) A $13" \times 71 \ 1/2"$ strip to each side of the center block.



3. Quilt and Bind

Use a backing fabric of your choice to create a quilt back. Make a quilt sandwich with the backing, batting and quilt front. Quilt using your favorite method. Trim edges and bind.
