## MAKING THE BLOCKS

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $\mathbf{G} 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Lay a marked square right sides together with (1) B 5-1/2" square. Sew 1/4" on opposite sides of the drawn line and cut on the line. Press each half-square triangle (HST) unit open and trim to measure $5^{\prime \prime}$ square. Make a total of (20) B-G HST units. In the same way, make the indicated number of each HST combination shown below.

2. To make Block \#1, lay out (2) B-G HST units, (1) B 5" square, and (1) H 5" square into (2) rows of (2) as shown. Sew into rows and join the rows to make (1) 9-1/2" square. Make a total of (10) B \#1 blocks. In the same way, make the indicated number of each \#1 block shown below.

3. To make Block \#2, lay out (2) D-H HST units, (1) D 5" square, and (1) G 5" square into (2) rows of (2) as shown. Sew into rows and join the rows to make (1) 9-1/2" square. Make a total of (10) D \#2 blocks. In the same way, make the indicated number of each \#2 block shown below.

## QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

4. Referring to the Quilt Assembly Diagram, lay out the blocks into (8) rows of (7) blocks each, noting orientation. Sew the blocks into rows and join the rows.

FINISHING
5. With the backing laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form the quilt sandwich. Baste the sandwich and quilt as desired.
6. Bind using the Fabric $\mathbf{G}$ strips to finish the quilt.
