

Α		25029S Ivory Solid	4-7/8	Quilt Center Patch Blocks: (2) 15 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (1) 15 1/2" x 15 1/2" square and (2) 8" x 15 1/2" rectangles from one strip. Sew remainder of strip and 2nd strip together, and subcut (1) 15 1/2" x 45 1/2" strip.  Inner border: (8) 2" x WOF. Piece strips and subcut (2) 2" x 75 1/2" and (2) 2" x 78 1/2" strips.  Pumpkin Blocks: (34) 1 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (40) 1 1/2" x 13 1/2" and (40) 1 1/2" x 15 1/2" rectangles. (9) 2 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (60) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares and (20) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles. (4) 3 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (40) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares. (2) 2 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (20) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. (3) 5 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (20) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. (3) 6 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (20) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles. (1) 6 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (20) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.



#### **Constructing Pumpkin Block A:**

- 1. Sew together rectangles from left to right:
- (1) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" **B** rectangle
- (1) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" I rectangle
- (1) 2" x 8 1/2" C rectangle
- (1) 3 1/2" x 8 1/2" **B** rectangle
- (1) 3" x 8 1/2" H rectangle
- (1) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" B rectangle
- 2. Draw a diagonal line on (1) 3 1/2" **A** square. Place on the top left corner of the pieced rectangle unit. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **A** corner triangle. Repeat with another 3 1/2" **A** square at the top right corner of the same pieced rectangle unit.

Repeat with (2) 2 1/2" A squares at the bottom left and bottom right corners of the same pieced rectangle unit to complete pumpkin body unit. Units measures 13 1/2" x 8 1/2" raw edge to raw edge.



3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 3 1/2" **D** square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 4" x 5 1/2" **A** rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **D** corner triangle.

Add (1) 2"  $\times$  5 1/2" **A** rectangle to the top of sewn unit to make left subunit, measuring 5 1/2"  $\times$  5 1/2" raw edge to raw edge.






4. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2 1/2" **D** square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 2 1/2" **x** 4 1/2" **A** rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **D** corner triangle. Add (1) 2 1/2" **A** square to the right of sewn unit.




Draw a diagonal line on the wrong sides of (1) 2 1/2" **D** square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" **A** rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **D** corner triangle.



Sew together sewn units, and add (1) 1  $1/2" \times 6 1/2"$  **A** rectangle to the top to make right subunit, measuring 6  $1/2" \times 5 1/2"$  raw edge to raw edge.




5. Sew subunits made in steps 3-4 to the opposite long sides of (1) 2  $1/2" \times 5 1/2"$  **F** rectangle to make pumpkin stalk unit, measuring 5  $1/2" \times 13 1/2"$  raw edge to raw edge.



6. Sew together pumpkin stalk and pumpkin body units. Sew (2) 1  $1/2" \times 13 1/2"$  **A** rectangles to the left and right sides, followed by (2) 1  $1/2" \times 15 1/2"$  **A** rectangles to the top and bottom to complete (1) pumpkin **A** block as shown on page 4.






Make a total of (7) blocks. Each block should measure 15 1/2" x 15 1/2".

### **Constructing Pumpkin Block B**

- 1. Sew together rectangles from left to right:
- (1) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" I rectangle
- (1) 3" x 8 1/2" **B** rectangle
- (1) 3 1/2" x 8 1/2" **G** rectangle
- (1) 2" x 8 1/2" C rectangle
- (1) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" **F** rectangle
- (1) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" **G** rectangle
- 2. Draw a diagonal line on (1) 3 1/2" **A** square. Place on the top left corner of the pieced rectangle unit. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **A** corner triangle. Repeat with another 3 1/2" **A** square at the top right corner of the same pieced rectangle unit. Repeat with (2) 2 1/2" **A** squares at the bottom left and bottom right corners of the same pieced rectangle unit to complete pumpkin body unit. Units measures 13 1/2" x 8 1/2" raw adds to raw edge.



3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 3 1/2" **D** square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 4" x 5 1/2" **A** rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **D** corner triangle.


Add (1) 2"  $\times$  5 1/2" **A** rectangle to the top of sewn unit to make left subunit, measuring 5 1/2"  $\times$  5 1/2" raw edge to raw edge.




4. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2 1/2" **D** square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 2 1/2" **x** 4 1/2" **A** rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **D** corner triangle. Add (1) 2 1/2" **A** square to the left of sewn unit.




Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2 1/2"  $\mathbf{D}$  square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 2 1/2"  $\times$  6 1/2"  $\mathbf{A}$  rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal  $\mathbf{D}$  corner triangle.



Sew together sewn units, and add (1) 1  $1/2" \times 6 1/2"$  **A** rectangle to the top to make right subunit, measuring 6  $1/2" \times 5 1/2"$  raw edge to raw edge.




5. Sew subunits made in steps 3-4 to the opposite long sides of (1) 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" **B** rectangle to make pumpkin stalk unit, measuring 5 1/2" x 13 1/2" raw edge to raw edge.





6. Sew together pumpkin stalk and pumpkin body units. Sew (2) 1  $1/2" \times 13 1/2"$  **A** rectangles to the left and right sides, followed by (2) 1  $1/2" \times 15 1/2"$  **A** rectangles to the top and bottom to complete (1) pumpkin **A** block.



Make a total of (13) blocks. Each block should measure 15 1/2" x 15 1/2".

### **Quilt Center Assembly**

1. Arrange and sew together pumpkin blocks and quilt center patch blocks to make pieced columns. Sew columns together to complete pieced portion of quilt center.

Pieced columns (from L to R):

Column 1: (2) block A, (3) block B

Column 2: (1) 15  $1/2" \times 15 1/2"$  **A** square, (1) block **A**, (3) block **B** 


Column 3: (1) 15 1/2" x 45 1/2" A rectangle, (1) block A, (1) block B

Column 4: (2) 8" x 15 1/2" A rectangles, (1) block A, (3) block B

Column 5: (2) block A, (3) block B

2. Using quilt center image on page 7 as placement guide, arrange bird applique pieces on pieced background. Once happy with placement, sew applique pieces in place.








### Quilt Top Assembly

- 1. Inner border. Sew (2) 2"  $\times$  75 1/2" **A** strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 2"  $\times$  78 1/2" **A** strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
- 2. Outer border. Sew (2) 4 1/2"  $\times$  78 1/2"  $\mathbf{E}$  strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 4 1/2"  $\times$  86 1/2"  $\mathbf{E}$  strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.



### **Quilting Instructions**

1. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired. Bind to finish quilt.
