Fabric Requirements:

2 ¼ yds Outer Border (31494-1) 1 ½ yds Inner Border & Binding (31496-1) ¾ yd Side & Corner Triangles (31495-3) 1 yd Alternate Squares (31493-1) 1 ¼ yds Background (31493-4) ¼ yd for Blocks of : 31496-1,2,3 31497-1,2,3

TRI-RECS tool by EZ Quilting Tools

Cutting Instructions:

31498-1,2,3

From Outer Border fabric (31494-1) cut:

4 - 8 1/2" LENGTHWISE strips - custom cut to center stripes.

From Inner Border fabric (31496-1) cut:

 $6-1\frac{1}{2}$ " strips – join ends to make one long strip. From this, cut 4-60" strips.

From Side & Corner Triangle fabric (31495-3) cut:

2-12" strips; cut into 4-12" squares. Cut squares diagonally twice.

From remaining strip, cut $2 - 6 \frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Cut both squares in half diagonally once, but cut them in opposite directions, according to the stripes.

From Alternate Square fabric (31493-1) cut:

4 - 8" strips; cut into 16 - 8" squares.

From Background fabric (31493-4) cut:

5-3 %" strips; cut into 54-3 %" squares.

 $2 - 2 \frac{1}{4}$ " strips; cut into $27 - 2 \frac{1}{4}$ " squares.

7 - 3"strips; cut into 216 RECS pieces.

From EACH fabric for blocks (31496-1,2,3 / 31497-1,2,3 / 31498-1,2,3) cut:

1-3%" strip; cut into 6-3%" squares

Cut remaining strip into $6 - 2 \frac{1}{4}$ " squares; cut in half diagonally once.


1 - 3" strip; cut into 12 TRI shapes.

Piecing Instructions:

Make Half Square Triangles from the 3 %" squares. Draw a line diagonally on the wrong side of all the Background squares. Pair a Background square with a colored square.

Sew 1/4" on both sides of the drawn line.

Cut on the line and press toward the color.

Sew a Background RECS shape to both angled sides of all the colored TRI shapes. Press toward the RECS shapes.





Using the 3" Background squares and the remaining triangles of colored fabric, make Square-in-a-Square blocks. Sew a colored triangle to each side of a Background square. Press away from the center.



Sew these three sections into blocks according to diagram. Press seams open. Make 27. You will use 25 of them.


Sew blocks on point in 5 rows of 5 using alternate squares and setting triangles. Use your 2 extra blocks to make sure you have good color placement. Pay special attention to the direction of the stripes in the setting triangles. Press toward the alternate squares.
