Fabric Requirements:

2 yards 37162-X Multi 1 yard 37164-2 Blue Fat Eighth each: 37163-1 Cream, 37164-3 Burgundy, 37165-1 Cream, 37165-2 Blue, 37165-4 Olive, 37166-2 Blue, 37166-3 Burgundy Mary's Blenders: 3/4 yards 32036-13 Tan Fat Eighth each: 32032-6 Dark Pink, 32036-7 Green, 32036-5 Pink, 32033-13 Tan, 32033-14 Brown Backing 3 2/3 yards

Cutting & Assembly:

1. From the (12) Twelve Fat 8th's cut (3) Three 2 ¾" strips from each fabric. Randomly choose two fabrics and sew them to make a strip set. Press seam open.

Sub-cut each strip set into 2 3/4" x 5" rectangles. (Each strip yields 7 sets) Randomly choose two rectangles and sew them together forming a Four Patch. Repeat this step to complete (21) Twenty One Four Patches. Diagram A Set aside remaining sets for the Final Border.

2. From fabric 32036-13 Tan cut the following:

Cut (9) Nine 7 5/8" Squares

Cut these squares twice on the diagonal to form (4) Four Triangles. Diagram B

Cut (6) Six 4 1/8" Squares

Cut these squares once on the diagonal to form (2) Two Triangles. Diagram C

Layout the rows as illustrated in Assembly Diagram.

Note: The small triangles are used on the end of the rows.



Cut (4) Four strips (LOF) length of fabric 7" wide. Note: This is a directional fabric you must cut on length of fabric.

Measure the length of each 4 patch strip. Take the average of these strips. This is the length you will cut your 7" strip. (approximately $44 \frac{1}{4}$ ").

Assemble the rows as shown in the Assembly Diagram.

Press to the 4 Patch rows.

4. From fabric 37164-2 Blue

Cut (6) Six 1 ½" strips (wof) width of fabric.

Sew these strips together end to end. Note: If you sew these strips together using a miter it will make the seam less noticeable.

Measure the two sides and the center of the quilt. Take the average. This is the length that you will cut your first two strips. (Approximately 44 $\frac{1}{4}$ ") This should match your measurement in step 3.

Sew these two strips to the sides of your quilt.

Press to the dark.

Measure the top, bottom and center of the quilt. Take the average. This is the length that you will cut your next two strips.

Sew these two strips to the top and bottom of the guilt.

Press to the dark.

5. Your Outside Border is made from the sets from Step 1.

Cut (6) Six 2 3/4" Squares from both fabrics (32036-13 Tan and 37162-X Multi)

Randomly assemble the squares and the strip sets into one long strip.

Remember this is random, just have fun with it.

Repeat the measuring process from Step 4 to cut your borders.


Assemble the same as Step 4.

6. Binding from fabric 37164-2 Blue


Cut (6) 2 1/2" strips. Sew together end to end.

7. Quilt the top using your favorite design and bind. ENJOY!
