	3/8 yard	1/2 yard	39761-X Multi	Block	Fussy cut 2 – 6 1/2" squares for each placemat.
	1/4 yard	1/4 yard	39766-5 Green	Sashing	For each placemat cut 3 – 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" & 2 – 1 1/2" x 15 1/2" pieces.
	1/4 yard	3/8 yard	39767-1 Red	Border	For each placemat cut 2 – 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" & 2 – 1 1/2" x 17 1/2" pieces.
	1/4 yard	1/2 yard	39764-2 Tan	Outer Border	For each placemat fussy cut 2 – 1" x 10 1/2" & 2 – 2 1/2" x 18 1/2" pieces.
	3/8 yard	5/8 yard	39765-1 Red	Binding	For each placemat cut 2 – 2 1/4" strips.
	1/2 yard	1 yard	39762-2 Tan	Backing	For each placemat cut 1 - 20" x 18"

Additional Material Needed: Fusible Fleece or Batting the same size as backing.

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Assembly Directions

1. Sew the green sashing pieces to the sides and connecting the two fussy cut chicken blocks.



2. Join the top and then the bottom sashing to the above unit.



3. Add the red sashing to the sides then the top and bottom as above.
4. As you fussy cut the outer borders pay attention to the direction of the words on the fabric choosing your words carefully!
5. Make the quilt sandwiches and quilt as desired! Trim and square up the placemat.
6. Sew binding strips together on the diagonal, trim and press seams open. Fold binding in half and press. Sew to the right side of the placemat, turn and sew in place.
