Fabric Requirements:

1 panel 36355P-X Multi 5/8 yard 34032-8 Orange (Spin Basic) 1/4 yard 36356-2 Purple for cutouts 1 Fat Quarter 36358-2 Purple Black Velcro, Batting and a piece of fast2fuseTM

Cutting:

Panels

Cut out each panel with 1/2" of orange on all sides of each house panel (outside of the green diamond border). Each panel will measure 17 1/2" x 15 3/4".

Cut the spider web border strips off the remaining sections of the panel. Trim off the black on one side. They should measure 2 1/2" wide x WOF. Sub cut into (2) 17 1/2" strips and (1) 12" strip. Set aside for the inside page of the book.

34032-8 Orange

Cut (1) piece 17 1/2" wide x 15 3/4" high. Cut the second piece 15 1/2" wide x 12" high.

Cut (1) piece following Template A,B,C

36358-2

Cut (1) piece following Template A,B,C

Batting

Cut (2) batting pieces 18 1/2" x 16 3/4".






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Preparing Book:

- 1. With the panels and batting together, quilt the (2) house panels using your favorite quilting method.
- 2. Cut small squares or buttons from one side of the velcro and sew to each house in various positions. This is where you will attach the ghost and ghouls figures later. Reserve the other side of the velcro for the figures. Trim away any excess batting.
- 3. Take 34032-8 orange 15 1/2" x 12" piece and sew the 12" spider web strip to the left side. Then add the top and bottom strips. Figure A
- 4. At this point you may personal your book by adding an embroidered or written message to a section about 12" wide by 9" high. Figure A



- 5. With right sides together, take quilted **outside** of the house panel and put it on top of the orange fabric with the border. Sew on 3 sides leaving the right side of the orange border fabric open. Figure A
- 6. Take the remaining 17 1/2" x 15 3/4" orange piece and join to the **inside** of the house panel also leaving the right side open.
- 7. Take the open seams of the 2 sides and watching the orientation (so that you get the front and inside positioned correctly) and sew the seams together leaving a 3" opening on the inside of the book for turning. Figure B
- 8. Slip stitch the opening closed. Add a topstitch down the center seam of the book to make it easier to fold in half. Figure C







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
Preparing the Ghosts & Ghouls:

Fabric- 36356-2 Purple

- 9. From the Ghost & Ghouls fabric, cut the various figures into a rectangle shape.
- 10. Following the manufacturer's instructions, fuse the wrong side of each rectangle to a corresponding size rectangle of fast2fuseTM. Protect the pressing surface and bottom of the iron with a piece of parchment paper.
- 11. Cut a corresponding size rectangle from the remaining 34032-8 Orange fabric and fuse the wrong side to the wrong side of the figure rectangle. Cut out each figure.
- 12. From the remaining side of the velcro, cut a small square or button and sew it to the middle of each figure. Place figures to the velcro placed on the book.

Making the Pouch:

- 13. Using joined templates A,B,C on last pages, cut (1) piece from 36358-2 Purple and (1) piece 34032-8 Orange.
- 14. With right sides together, stitch around the diamond leaving a 3" opening so that the envelope can be turned to the right side. Turn and slip stitch the opening to close.
- 14. Cut the button from the excess spider web pattern on the panel borders. Center the spider in the middle of the circle. Cut one more circle from the 36358-2 Purple for button backing. Figure D
- 15. Cut a small piece of batting. Sew the batting to the spider side with an edge stitch. Trim excess
- 16. With right sides together, sew the circle to the backing leaving a small opening for turning. Clip the seam allowance all around to make the circle more even when turned. Turn and slip stitch the opening closed.
- 17. Cut a band of silhouette figures 7 1/4" x 3" from the bottom or the top of the panel. Center and applique on outside of envelope using your favorite method. Figure D




18. Take a small square or button of black velcro and sew it to the inside on the top point. Figure E On the outside, edge stitch the spider 'button' to cover the point with a slight overhang. Figure D



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20. With the wrong side up, make the envelope by folding the bottom point up and then the sides matching points at the center. Not the finsihed size should be about 7 1/2" wide X 5" high.



21. Hand stitch the 'points' together so that they will not shift. Then take the other side of the small square or button of velcro and sew it onto the center of point. Make sure the position of the velcro aligns properly with the velcro on the top point. Step 3

Now you have a place to store your cut out ghost and ghoulish figures.

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Make Envelope Template as follows:


Cut templates from the project sheet as shown in diagram below.

Join the template pieces together following layout.

Trace onto card stock to make template.

Add 1/4" seam allowance to all sides.

Then cut from fabric as instructed.
