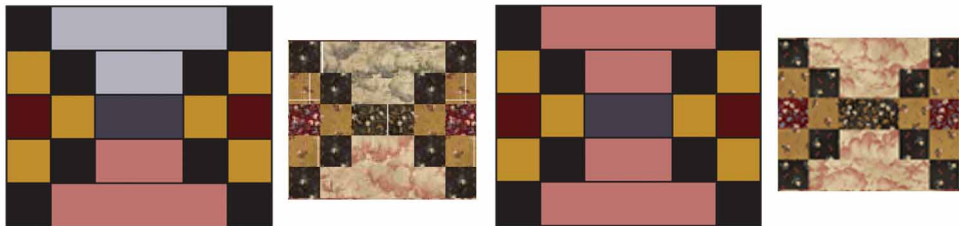


Give Me Liberty

- Sew a 2-1/2" black scattered flower square to each end of a 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" red cloud strip. Make 16 units.
- Sew a strip with 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" black clouds to one side of a center unit. Sew a strip with 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" red clouds to the other side of a center unit. Make 8. Sew a strip with 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" black clouds to the black side of the center unit. Sew a strip with 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" red clouds to the red side of the center unit to complete the block. Make 8 blocks.
- Sew a strip with 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" red clouds to both sides of a center unit. Make 4. Sew a strip with 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" red clouds to both sides of the center unit to complete the block. Make 4 blocks.

Quilt Assembly

- Rows 1 and 5: alternate 3 Churn Dash blocks with 2 red/black cloud setting blocks to make a row. Make 2 rows.

- Row 3: alternate 3 Churn Dash blocks with 2 red cloud blocks to make the row.
- Rows 2 and 4: alternate setting blocks and fussy cut red toile scenes to complete the row. Each row will have a red/black cloud block at the ends and a red cloud blocks in the center.
- Sew the rows together in numerical order to complete the quilt center.
- Sew a 1-1/2" x 70-1/2" red medallion border strip to the bottom edge of a red 5-1/2" x 70-1/2" damask print border to make a border unit. Make 4 border units.
- Center a border strip unit on one side of the quilt center. Pin out towards edge leaving at least a 7" overlap. Pin 1/4" from edge of quilt center at each end and sew the border strip in place, stopping at the pin 1/4" from each end. Repeat on each side of the quilt. Miter the corners and trim away excess fabric.

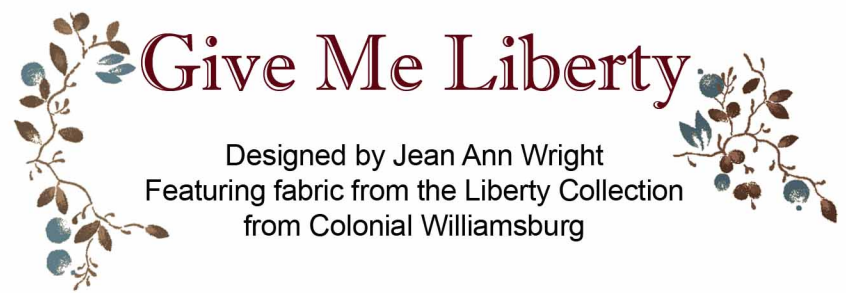
Finishing

- Layer the quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt the layers together. Bind the outside edges with double fold binding to complete. **ENJOY!**

Liberty Quilt

Quilt designed by Jean Ann Wright

Quilt size: 66" x 66"

Churn Dash Blocks: 10" x 10"

Setting blocks: 12" x 10"

Fabric requirements

2 yards #30754-2 red damask print for outside border

Cut (8) 5-1/2" x width of fabric strips for borders, fussy cut so pattern will match when sewn together for borders.

Match Sew together end-to-end and cut as follows:

(4) strips 5-1/2" x 70-1/2" for outside borders

1 yard #30753-2 red medallion print

(8) 1-1/2" x wof strips, sew together end-to end and recut into

(4) 1-1/2" x 70-1/2" border strips

(8) 2-1/4" x wof strips, sew together end-to-end for binding

1/2 yard #30747-2 red toile scene print

(sufficient to fussy cut 4 full pictures 12-1/2" x 12-1/2" as shown in quilt photo)

1/2 yard #30748-2 red coin print

Cut (3) 4-7/8" x wof strips, crosscut into (18) 4-7/8" squares.

Cut each square in half on diagonal once to make (36) triangles

1/2 yard #30750-1 yd black scattered flowers

Cut (6) 2-1/2" x wof strips, cross cut into (96) 2-1/2" squares

1/8 yard #30750-2 red scattered flowers

Cut (1) 2-1/2" x wof strip, cross cut into (9) 2-1/2" squares

1/2 yard #30750-4 tan scattered flowers

Cut (5) 2-1/2" x wof strips, cross cut into (72) 2-1/2" squares

1/3 yard #30751-1 black clouds

Cut (3) 2-1/2" x wof strips, cross cut into:

(8) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips and

(8) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips

2/3 yard #30751-2 red clouds

Cut (6) 2-1/2" x wof strips, cross cut into:

(16) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips and

(16) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips

1/2 yard #30753-4 cream medallions

Cut (3) 4-7/8" x wof strips, crosscut into (18) 4-7/8" squares.

Cut each square in half on diagonal once to make (36) triangles

1/2 yard #30752-4 cream allover flowers

(5) 2-1/2" x wof strips, cross cut into (36) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips

1/4 yard #30752-1 black allover flowers

(2) 2-1/2" x wof strips, cross cut into (12) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips

1 yard #30752-2 red allover flowers

(2) 2-1/2" x wof strips, cross cut into (24) 2-1/2" squares

Backing: 3 yards 30748-4 cream coins

Cut and piece into backing 3" larger all around than quilt top

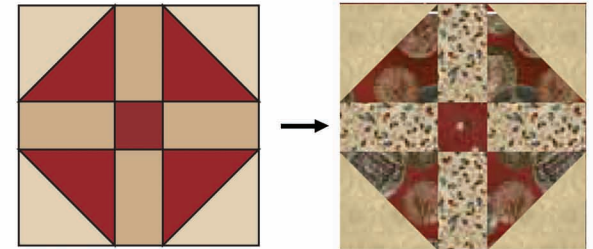
Sewing the Churn Dash Blocks:

1. Sew the 36 red coin triangles to the 36 cream medallion triangles to make 36 squares. Press seams toward red triangles.

2. Sew a red/cream half square triangle squares to opposite sides of a cream allover flower 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle. Make 18 triangle/square units.

3. Sew a cream allover flower 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle to opposite sides of a red scattered flower 2-1/2" square. Make 9 bar units.

4. Sew a triangle/square unit to each long side of a bar unit to complete a block. Make 9 blocks.

Sewing the Setting Blocks:

5. Sew a 2-1/2" black scattered flower square to each end of a 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" black cloud strip. Make 8 units.

6. Sew a 2-1/2" black scattered flower square to each end of a 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" black cloud strip. Sew a 2-1/2" tan scattered flower square to each end of this strip, attaching to the black scattered flower squares. Make 8 units.

7. Sew a 2-1/2" tan scattered flower square to each end of a black 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" red cloud allover flower strip. Sew a 2-1/2" red scattered flower square to each end of the unit. Make 12 center units.

8. Sew a 2-1/2" black scattered flower square to each end of a 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" red cloud strip. Sew a 2-1/2" tan scattered flower square to each black square. Make 16 units.
