

SAMPLE	KEY/ SKU	QTY	CUTTING FOR THE QUILT
	32021-X Multi	2 3/4 yards	For top and bottom borders cut 2 strips 6" x 61" on length of fabric. For side borders cut 2 strips 6" x 76 1/2" on length of fabric. For the backing trim remaining fabric to 18" wide by the length of fabric.
THE STATE OF THE S	32026-1 Blue	3/8 yard	For strip set #1 cut 4 strips 2 1/2" by width of fabric.
No.	32024-1 Blue	3/8 yard	For strip set #1 cut 4 strips 2 1/2" by width of fabric.
	32022-1 Blue	3/8 yard	For strip set #1 cut 4 strips 2 1/2" by width of fabric.
	32025-5 Green	3/8 yard	For strip set #1 cut 4 strips 2 1/2" by width of fabric.
一	32026-5 Green	3/8 yard	For strip set #2 cut 4 strips 2 1/2" by width of fabric.
	32022-2 Red	3/8 yard	For strip set #2 cut 4 strips 2 1/2" by width of fabric.
	32025-6 Rust	3/8 yard	For strip set #2 cut 4 strips 2 1/2" by width of fabric.
	32024-2 Red	1 yard	For strip set #1 cut 4 strips 2 1/2" by width of fabric. For binding cut 9 strips 2" wide by the width of fabric. Join together with diagonal seams to make one long piece. Press in half.
RESISTANT PORTAL	32023-3 Cream	2 3/4 yards	For sashing strips cut 4 strips at 5 1/2" x 76 1/2" on the length of the fabric. For backing cut 1 strip 18" wide by the length of the fabric.
	32025-4 Brown	23/4 yards	For backing cut yardage in half down the length of the fabric.

You will also need: 72" x 90" (Twin) Warm & Natural Batting Mary Ellen's Best Press Starch



INSTRUCTIONS:



Step 1: Making the shutters.

Using fabric strips for strip set #1, sew one of each together to make a strip set of 4 fabrics. Press all seams in one direction. Make 4.

Cut each strip set into 10 1/2" wide blocks. Make 15.

Repeat for strip set #2.

Sew 5 - #1 blocks alternating with 5 - #2 blocks to make a long column of 10 blocks.

Press all seams in one direction. Make 3.

Trim bottom of columns to measure 76 1/2" long.

Step 2: Making the sashing columns.

Starting and ending with a sashing column, sew sashing and shutter columns alternately together to make the top of the quilt. It should measure 50 1/2" x 76 1/2".

Step 3: Add the borders.

Sew the precut side border to each side.

Sew the top and bottom borders on to the quilt and trim to fit.

Step 4: Piece the backing.

Join the two strips from the top quilt fabric together. On each side add a strip of the precut backing fabric. Iron seams flat.

Step 5: Finish up.

Make the quilt sandwich and quilt as desired. Trim off excess batting and backing. Bind off to finish.
