

They look like "Attic Windows" but there are no set-in seams! Perfect for cuddling up in front of the fire, this throw is great for the woods, or the home that wishes it was in the woods!

Fussy cut the motifs in the windows, picking your favorites.


All seams are 1/4" unless otherwise noted. Fabric yardage is based on 40" wide.

NOTES:

- Don't trim your borders to the listed length until the center of the quilt is put together and you can check if the measurements are correct. Always measure the middle of the quilt, not the sides, which can stretch while you measure.
- As you cut your pieces, put them on separate paper plates and label them. You will always know which is which then.

Sewing Instructions:

• Begin constructing the blocks by marking the light colored 4 1/4" squares down the middle on the wrong side, diagonally, and 1/4" on each side of the center line. Fig A.





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


 With right sides together, sew the green and gold squares together on the dotted lines. Cut apart on the solid line. FIG. B. Press seams to the green. Trim square to a perfect 3 3/4".

Cont.

- Sew a green 7 1/4" x 3 3/4" rectangle to the left side of each of the 9 motifs.
- Sew the two-colored square on the left side of the gold 7 1/4" x 3 3/4" rectangle as shown above.
- Join the two units to create the block. FIG. C.
- Make 9. They should measure 10 1/2" including the seams.
- Following the picture, sew sashing to the sides of the blocks.
- Following the picture, sew 4 rows of horizontal sashing.
- Join the blocks and sashing to create the center of the guilt.
- Add the borders one at a time, adding first to the sides and then to the top and bottom.
- Make a guilt sandwich and guilt as desired.
- Join the binding pieces with diagonal seams. Press in half and bind the edges.
- Curl up in front of the fire and enjoy!!!
