





#### Fabric Requirements

1 1/4 yards 39301-5 Blue 5/8 yard 31839 Lt Pink 1930s Solid 5/8 yard 31835 White Solid 5/8 yard 39305-2 Yellow

#### 1/4 yard each of prints:

39302-2 Yellow 39304-5 Blue 39306-7 Lilac 39310-7 Lilac 39300-2 Yellow 39307-3 Peach 39308-6 Pink 39307-1 Green

3/8 yard each 1930s Solid 25031 Periwinnkle 25027 Banana 25025 Pink 25026 Mint

BACKING: 4 yards BINDING: 5/8 yard



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### **Cutting Instructions:**

Blue Solid (25031):	(2) 3 7/8" strips	(10) 3 7/8" squares
Yellow Solid (25027):	(2) 3 7/8" strips	(10) 3 7/8" squares
Green Solid (25026):	(2) 3 7/8" strips	(10) 3 7/8" squares
Pink Solid (25025):	(2) 3 7/8" strips	(10) 3 7/8" squares
White (31835):	(4) 3 7/8" strips	(40) 3 7/8" squares
Print (39305-2):	(4) 3 7/8" strips	(40) 3 7/8" squares
Prints from each of following: Yellow (39302-2) Yellow (39300-2) Lilac (39306-7) Lilac (39310-7) Pink (39308-6) Peach (39307-3) Green (39307-1) Blue (39304-5)	(4) 2" strips	
Light Pink (31839):	(8) 2 ½" strips	Inner Border
Blue (39301-5):	(8) 4 ½" strips	Outer Border

### Piecing Instructions: Note: ALL seams are 1/4 inch

1. Layer (1) Blue Solid and (1) White 3 7/8" square, right sides together. Crosscut in half on the diagonal. Repeat with (9) more pairs. Sew seam to create Half Square Triangle units. Press towards the Blue. Trim Extensions. You will have (20) Half Square Triangle units. Repeat with Yellow, Green, and Pink Solids. Set aside.











2. Layer (1) Blue Solid and (1) Print 3 7/8" square, right sides together. Crosscut in half on the diagonal. Repeat with (9) more pairs. Sew seam to create Half Square Triangle units. Press towards the Blue. Trim Extensions. You will have (20) Half Square Triangle units. Repeat with Yellow, Green, and Pink Solids. Set aside.














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3. Sew strip sets: Using four different 2" strips, sew the (4) strips together lengthwise. Press seams in one direction. Strip sets should measure 6 ½" high. Repeat until you have (4) strip sets. Cross cut strip sets at 3 ½". You will need (40) units.



- 4. Using four different 2" strips, sew the (4) strips together lengthwise. Press seams in one direction. Strip sets should measure 6 ½" high. Repeat until you have (4) strip sets. Cross cut strip sets at 3 ½". You will need (40) units.
- 5. Layout block: Using the same (4) solid half square triangle units with white, (4) solid half square triangle units with print and (4) strip sets-(2) of each set, layout block as shown. You will need 5 of each color way. Sew together and press. Block should measure 12 ½".












#### Putting it all together:

1. Layout blocks: (4) blocks per row, one of each solid color. Sew (5) rows together.




- 2. Sew rows together to create quilt top. Press well. Quilt should measure:  $48 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $60 \frac{1}{2}$ ".
- 3. Inner Border: Sew to top, bottom and both sides. Press. Quilt should measure:  $52 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $64 \frac{1}{2}$ ".

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4. Outer Border: Sew to top, bottom and both sides. Press. Quilt should measure:  $60 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $72 \frac{1}{2}$ ".



5. Quilt as desired, bind and enjoy!
