# TIMBER STRIPE QUILT

Finished size = 42" x 62 ½"

## Materials:

30845-5 Pear Mist = 1/8 yard  
30840-1 Dogwood River = 3/8 yard  
30842-4 Maple Java = ¼ yard  
30847-2 Gingko Malibu = 1/8 yard  
30844-3 Willow Sweetgrass = ¼ yard  
30840-2 Dogwood Malibu = 3/8 yard  
30846-4 Bamboo Java = 1/8 yard  
30841-2 Magnolia Sugar Plum = 1/8 yard  
30847-1 Gingko Sea Glass = ¼ yard  
30842-3 Maple Sweetgrass = 1/8 yard  
30843-1 Apple Mist = 3/8 yard  
30842-1 Magnolia River = 1/8 yard  
30847-4 Gingko Java = 3/8 yard  
30844-1 Willow Mist = 1/8 yard  
30846-1 Bamboo Sea Glass = 1/8 yard  
30845-2 Pear Sugar Plum = 1/8 yard  
30844-4 Willow River = 1/8 yard  
30842-2 Maple Sugar Plum = 1/8 yard

Binding = ½ yard  
(pictured is Bamboo Sea Glass)

Backing = 2 yards  
(assumes backing is as wide as the other fabrics)

## cutting:

Cut strips across the width of the fabric of the following lengths:

Pear Mist = 3 ½"  
Dogwood River = 4 ¼" and 4 ½"  
Maple Java = 1 ½" and 1 ½" and 1 ¼"  
Gingko Malibu = 1 ¾"  
Willow Sweetgrass = 3" and 1 ½"  
Dogwood Malibu = 5 ½" and 3 ¾"  
Bamboo Java = 1 ¼"  
Magnolia Sugar Plum = 3 ¾"  
Gingko Sea Glass = 3" and 3"  
Maple Sweetgrass = 1 ½"  
Apple Mist = 6 ½" and 4 ½"  
Magnolia River = 2 ¾"  
Gingko Java = 1 ¾" and 3 ¼"  
Willow Mist = 1 ½"  
Bamboo Sea Glass = 1 ½"  
Pear Sugar Plum = 3 ½"  
Willow River = 3 ¾"  
Maple Sugar Plum = 1 ¾"

## Sewing:

Simply sew the strips together as shown in the drawing  
(*Hint: the cutting directions list the measurements in the order they appear from top to bottom*) with a ¼" seam.

Line all your strips up on the same edge while sewing.  
Trim off selvedge on that edge.  
Trim opposite edge to even out.  
Add batting and backing.  
Quilt as desired.  
Bind with 2 ¼" double-fold binding.
