


Cutting Instructions:

Template 1 and 2 must be cut from a single layer of fabric. Template 3 can be cut from a double layer of fabric. WOF= Width of Fabric




Sewing Instructions:


1. Take a **Fabric C** HST and sew a **Fabric A** HST to the top. Press towards **Fabric C**. Take two more **Fabric** A HST and sew them to either side as shown. Press towards **Fabric C** to make Trunk Unit. Repeat to make (31) Trunk Units.



2. Sew a Template 1 piece and to the left side of a Template 3 piece. Press towards Template 3. Sew a Template 2 piece to the right side of the Template 3 piece. Press towards Template 3 to make a Tree Unit. Repeat with all remaining Template 1, 2, and 3 pieces to make (31) Tree Units.



3. Sew a Tree Unit and to the bottom of a Tree Unit as shown to make a Tree Block. Trim and square to 8 1/2"x 8 1/2". Repeat with the remaining A and B Units to make (31) Tree Blocks total.






4. Sew the (6) 2" x WOF C strips short ends together into one long strip. Measure the quilt length and cut (2) strips to that length. Sew to the sides of the quilt. Measure the quilt width, including borders added, and cut (2) strips to that length. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.

5. Sew the (7) 3-1/2" x WOF B strips short ends together into one long strip. Measure and add borders in the same manner as in Step 5.

Assembly

6. Sew the Tree Blocks together into diagonal rows, as shown in the layout diagram, with the **Fabric A** QSTs and HSTs. Sew the diagonal rows into the quilt top. Trim quilt top 1/4" psat block points.





- 7. Make a backing approx 63"x 74" from **Fabric K**.
- 8. Layer the backing right side down, batting, and quilt top right side up. Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the quilt top.
- 9. Piece the 2 1/4" x WOF **Fabric J** strips using diagonal seams to make a continuous binding. Sew the binding around the quilt top. Turn the binding to the back and secure in place by hand or machine. Label and enjoy.
