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## Estimated Fabric Requirements:

- 1 panel – 50091P-X Multi
- 1 yard – 50095-2 Storm
- 2 ¾ yards – 50095-1 Blue
- ½ yard – 50092-X Multi
- ¼ yard – 35370S-2 Black
- ¼ yard – 50093-X Multi
- ¼ yard – 50095-4 Red
- 1 yard – 37098-10 Burnt Umber
- 2 ⅛ yards – 50094-2 Storm
- 2 ⅛ yards – 50094-1 Blue
- 4 ½ yards – 50093-X Multi

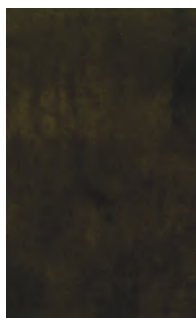

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## Cutting Instructions:

Fabric A: On Frozen Pond Panel - Multi

- Fussy cut two 24 ½" x 16 ½" panels.

Fabric B: Chain - Storm

- Cut two 2 ½" x Width of Fabric (WOF) strips. Sub-cut the strips into four 2 ½" x 16 ½" strips.
- Cut four 2 ½" x 28 ½" WOF strips.
- See instructions to cut two of Frame #2

Fabric C: Chain - Blue

- Cut four 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 2" x 71 ½" strips.
- Cut four 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 2" x 69 ½" strips.
- See instructions to cut two of Frame #1
- Cut eight 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric D: Village - Multi

- Cut one 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into two 7" x 14 ¼" strips.
- Cut one 7 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into two 7 ½" squares.

Fabric E: Black

- Cut one 1 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 1 ¼" x 7" strips.
- Cut two 1 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into four 1 ¼" x 15 ¾" strips.

Fabric F: Skaters - Multi

- Cut one 7 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into two 7 ½" squares.

Fabric G: Chain - Red

- Cut two 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight 1" x 7 ½" strips.
- Cut two 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eight 1" x 8 ½" strips.

Fabric H: Palette – Burnt Umber

- See instructions to cut four of Frame #3

Fabric I: Sky - Storm

- Cut eight 4 ½" x 69 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.

Fabric J: Sky - Blue

- Cut nine 4 ½" x 69 ½" LOF strips.

Backing: Skaters - Multi

- Cut two 79" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 79" x 80" for the pieced back.



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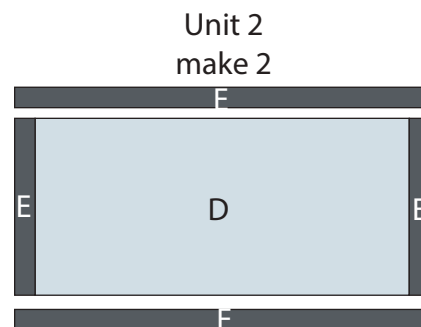
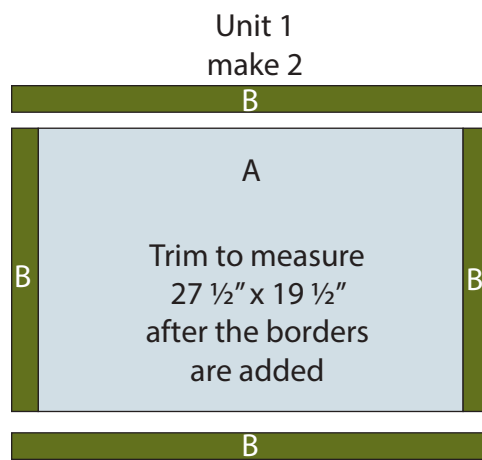
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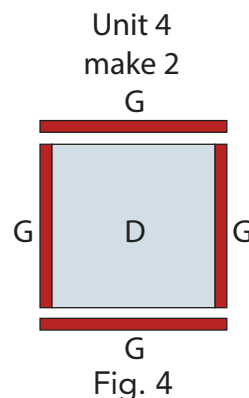
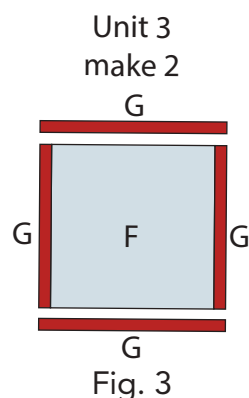
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## Block Assembly:

1. Sew one  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $16\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of one  $24\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $16\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A panel. Sew one  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $28\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure  $27\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $19\frac{1}{2}$ " to make one Unit 1 block (Fig. 1). Repeat to make a second Unit 1 block.
2. Sew one  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x 7" Fabric E strip to each side of one  $14\frac{1}{4}$ " x 7" Fabric D strip. Sew one  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $15\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric D strip to make one Unit 2 block (Fig. 2). Repeat to make a second Unit 2 block.



3. Sew one  $1$ " x  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to each side of one  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F square. Sew one  $1$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric F square to make one Unit 3 block (Fig. 3). Repeat to make a second Unit 3 block.
4. Sew one  $1$ " x  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to each side of one  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square. Sew one  $1$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric D square to make one Unit 4 block (Fig. 4). Repeat to make a second Unit 4 block.



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5. Sew nine 4 ½" x 69 ½" Fabric J strips and eight 4 ½" x 69 ½" Fabric I strips together lengthwise and alternating them to make one JI block (Fig. 5).
6. Sew one 2" x 69 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the JI block. Sew one 2" x 71 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the JI block to make the Background Layout (Fig. 5).

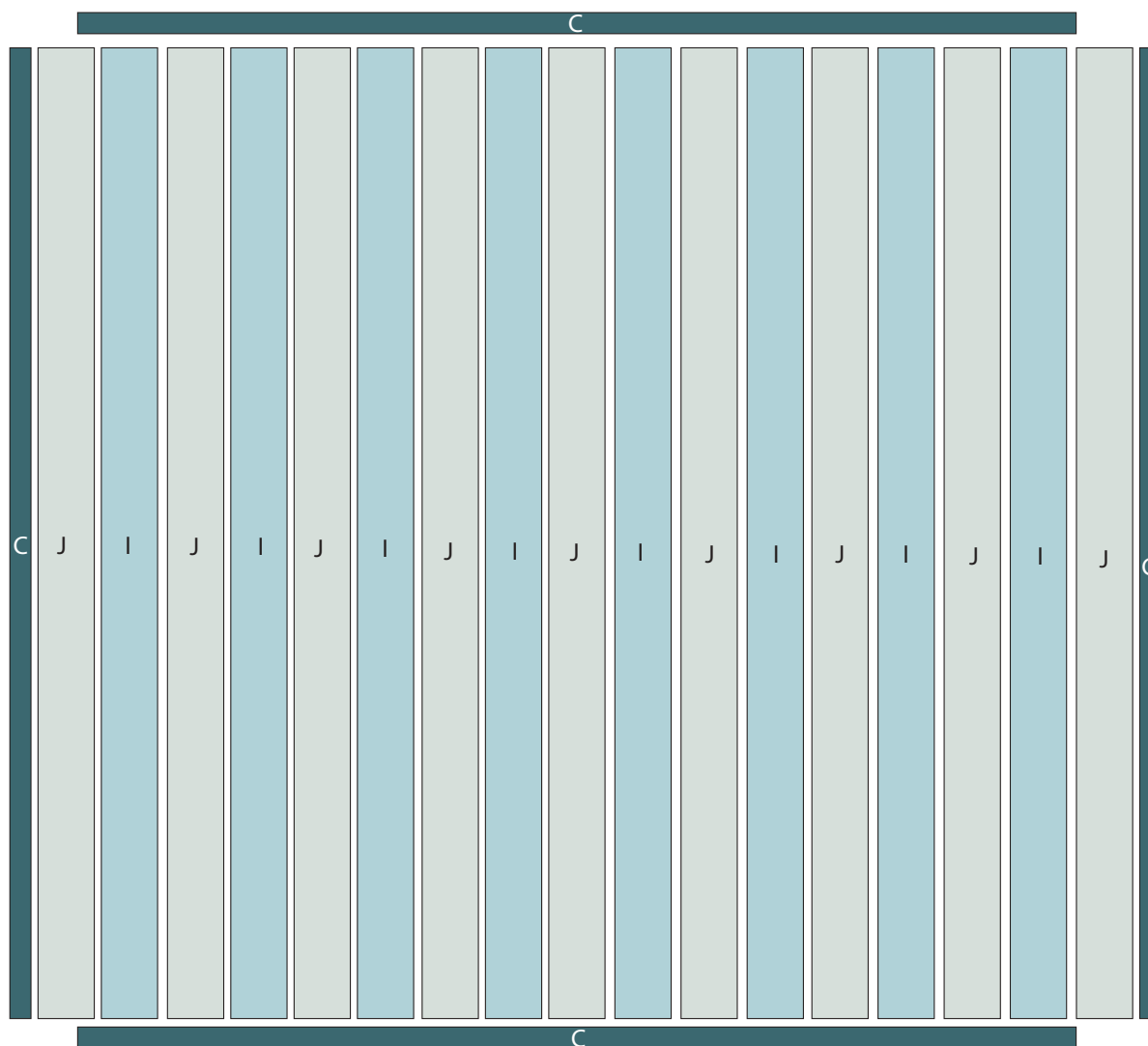

## **Quilt Top Assembly – Refer to Figure 6 on Page 6 while assembling the quilt top:**

7. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
8. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.

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9. Add fusible web to the backside of Units 1-4 blocks.
10. Refer to the quilt photo and Figure 6 for placement to position one Unit 1 block onto the background. Position one Frame 1 on top of the unit, making sure it is centered. Repeat to position and press the second Unit 1 and Frame 1 in place.
11. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to finish the first unit.
12. Repeat Steps 10-12 and add the two Unit 2 blocks and Frames, the two Unit 3 blocks and Frames and the two Unit 4 blocks and frames to finish the quilt top.
13. Layer and quilt as desired.
14. Sew the eight  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half, lengthwise with wrong sides together, and press.
15. Bind as desired.

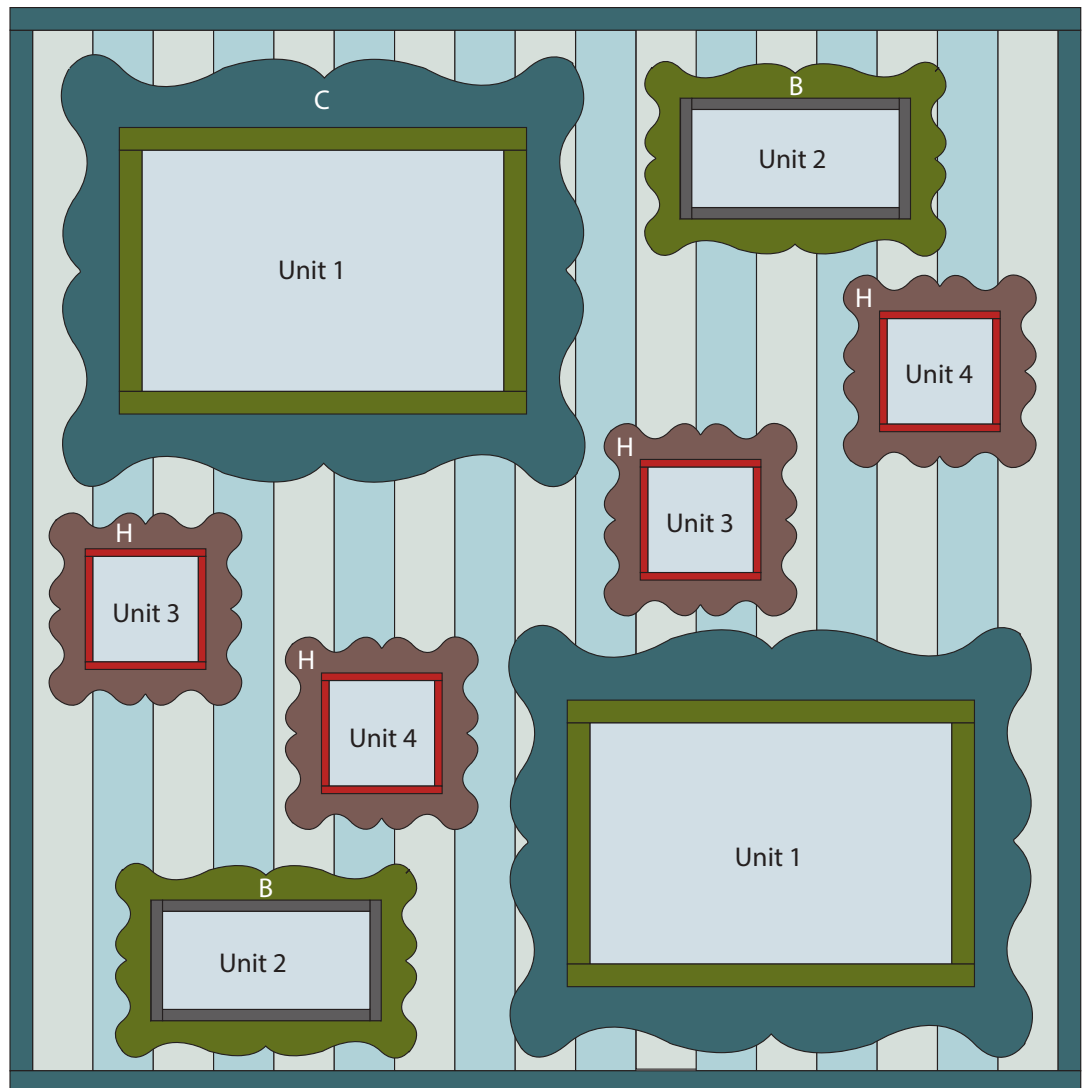

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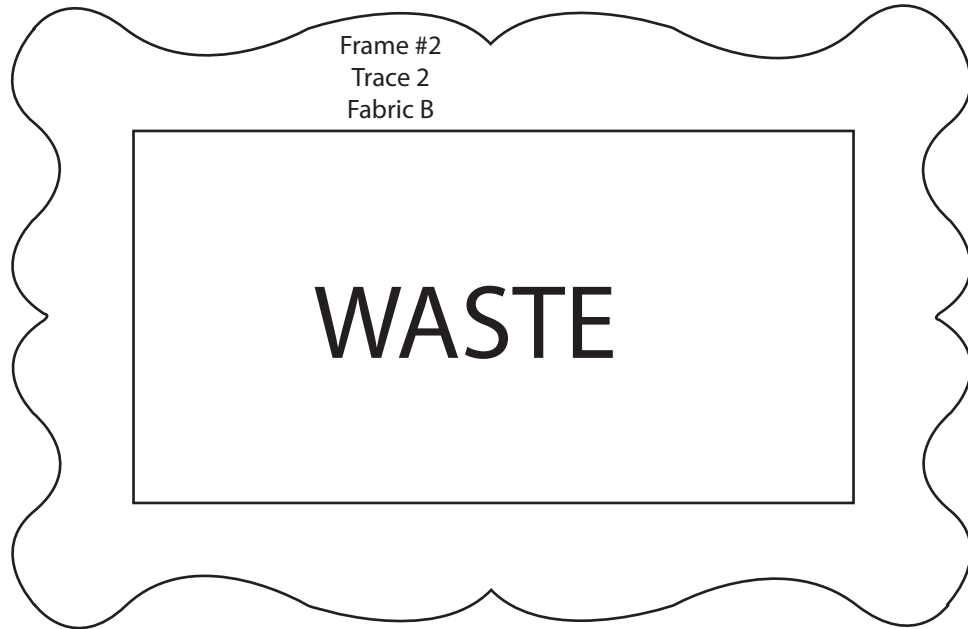
