
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### Piecing Instructions:

(Refer to block images below for proper rotation of directional fabrics)


### **BLOCKS 1, 2, 3 & 4:** (Square all blocks to 6-1/2")

- 1. Take (1) E 1-3/4" square and either fold diagonally and press with iron or draw diagonal line on the wrong side. Place **E** square right sides together on one corner of (1) A 6-1/2" square and sew on diagonal line. Press with seam allowance towards the **E** fabric. Trim excess fabric on reverse side to 1/4". Repeat for the remaining 3 corners to complete **BLOCK 1**, make (4).
- 2. Repeat step 1 using (4) E 1-3/4" squares and (1) B 6-1/2" square to make **BLOCK 2**, make (4).
- 3. Repeat step 1 using (4) D 1-3/4" squares and (1) B 6-1/2" square to make BLOCK 3, make (4).
- 4. Sew (1) **G** 1-1/2" X 4-1/2" rectangle to each side of (1) **A** 4-1/2" square, then sew (1) G 2-1/2" X 6-1/2" rectangle to top and bottom. Repeat step 1 using (4) **E** 1-3/4" squares on corners to make **BLOCK 4**, make (1).



### **BLOCKS 5 & 6:** (Square all blocks to 6-1/2")

- 5. Line up (1) **D** 1-3/4" X 5-1/4" rectangle along the top and right side of (1) **C** 4" square. Sew pieces together, stopping about 1-1/2" from bottom of **C** square.
- Press with seam allowance towards the **D** fabric.
- 7. Sew (1) E 1-3/4" X 5-1/4" rectangle to top, press with seam allowance towards E fabric.
- 8. Sew (1) **D** 1-3/4" X 5-1/4" rectangle to left side, press with seam allowance towards **D** fabric.
- 9. Sew (1) E 1-3/4" X 5-1/4" rectangle to bottom, press with seam allowance towards E fabric.
- 10. Finish sewing partial seam created in step 4 to complete **BLOCK 5**, make (6).
- 11. Repeat steps 4-9, placing **E** rectangles on left and right sides and **D** rectangles on top and bottom of C square to create **BLOCK 6**, make (6).





### **BORDER BLOCKS 1, 2 & 3:**

- 12. Sew (1) **E** 1-3/4" square to one end of (1) **D** 1-3/4" X 5-1/4" rectangle to complete **BORDER BLOCK 1**. Square to 1-3/4" X 6-1/2", make (12).
- 13. As in step number 1, sew (1) **D** 1-3/4" square to each end of (1) **G** 1-3/4" X 6-1/2" rectangle to complete BORDER BLOCK 2. Square to 1-3/4" X 6-1/2", make (8).
- 14. Take (1) G 1-3/4" square and either fold diagonally and press with iron or draw diagonal line on the wrong side. Place **G** square right sides together with (1) **D** 1-3/4" square and sew on diagonal line. Press with seam allowance towards the **D** (darker) fabric. Trim excess fabric on reverse side to ¼" to complete **BORDER BLOCK 3**. Square to 1-3/4", make (4).

### BORDER BLOCK 1 (make 12)















- 15. Sew (3) BORDER BLOCK 1s and (2) BORDER BLOCK 2s together as shown to make LEFT BORDER UNIT.
- 16. Sew (3) BORDER BLOCK 1s and (2) BORDER BLOCK 2s together as shown to make RIGHT BORDER UNIT.
- 17. Sew (3) BORDER BLOCK 1s, (2) BORDER BLOCK 2S, and (2) BORDER BLOCK 3s together as shown to make TOP BORDER UNIT.
- 18. Sew (3) BORDER BLOCK 1s, (2) BORDER BLOCK 2S, and (2) BORDER BLOCK 3s together as shown to make BOTTOM BORDER UNIT.

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### **Assembly Instructions**

(Refer to quilt diagram and cover image for proper placement and rotation of blocks)

### **Quilt Assembly:**

19. Sew blocks together into horizontal rows, then sew rows together.

ROWS 1 & 5: Block 1 – Block 5 – Block 2 – Block 5 – Block 1 ROWS 2 & 4: Block 6 – Block 3 – Block 6 – Block 3 – Block 6 ROW 3: Block 2 – Block 5 – Block 4 – Block 5 – Block 2

### **Border Assembly:**

#### BORDER #1:

20. Sew Left and Right Border Units to sides of quilt, then sew Top and Bottom Border Units to top and bottom of quilt.

#### BORDER #2:

21. Sew (1) **G** 1-3/4" X 33" strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) **G** 1-3/4" X 35-1/2" strip to the top and bottom of quilt.

#### BORDER #3:

22. Sew (1) **F** 1-3/4" X 35-1/2" strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) **F** 1-3/4" X 38" strip to the top and bottom of quilt.

#### BORDER #4:

23. Sew (1) D 4-1/2" X 38" strip to each side of quilt. Sew (1) A 4-1/2" square to each end of (1) D 4-1/2" X 38" strip, make (2), then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

### Finishing:

Backing and batting should be 8" larger than finished quilt top. Layer your backing, batting and quilt top, then quilt as desired. Bind using your preferred method ... and enjoy!

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
